Supreme Court lets convicted Dallas man change guilty plea

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Supreme Court let stand a ruling that a Texas man once convicted of cocaine trafficking is entitled to change his 1987 guilty plea.

The court, without comment, refused Monday to hear Justice Department arguments that a judge's failure to inform the man of the charges he faced amounted to "harmless error."

Mario Bernal was arrested in Dallas two years ago as he was selling a kilogram of cocaine, priced at \$30,000, to an undercover agent of the federal Drug Enforcement Administration.

Bernal initially pleaded innocent to cocaine-related charges but later entered a plea bargain agreement under which he pleaded guilty to one of the charges.

In the appeal acted on today, government lawyers emphasized a part of the same federal rule that says, "Any variance from the procedures required . . . which does not affect substantial rights shall be disregarded."

The 5th Circuit court had said that part of the rule "is designed to forgive inadequate addresses (by judges), not entire failures" to discuss with a defendant the nature of the charges against him.

But other federal appeals courts have ruled that such failures by judges may be harmless error.

"The record of (Bernal's) plea proceeding establishes beyond a shadow of a doubt that he understood the offense to which he was pleading guilty," Justice Department lawyers said.

The government lawyers urged that "reversals be reserved for those cases in which an error has had some effect on the voluntariness or accuracy of the defendant's guilty plea."
