

ers can help in the battle against global warming by planting more trees now, an Environmental Protection Agency official told foresters on

"Forest management decisions should begin considering climate very soon," said Kenneth Andrasko, senior forest analyst with the EPA policy and analysis office in Wash-

Andrasko and Mike Hall, director in the field, Andrasko said. of the climatic and atmospheric re-search office for the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, spoke on the phenomenon of global warming to about 100 people at a National Association of State Foresters conference.

Global warming involves a so-called "greenhouse effect" in which heat can be reflected from Earth or of this program as we speak," he sa trapped in the atmosphere. Carbon emissions contribute to the trend.
