Club Volleyball

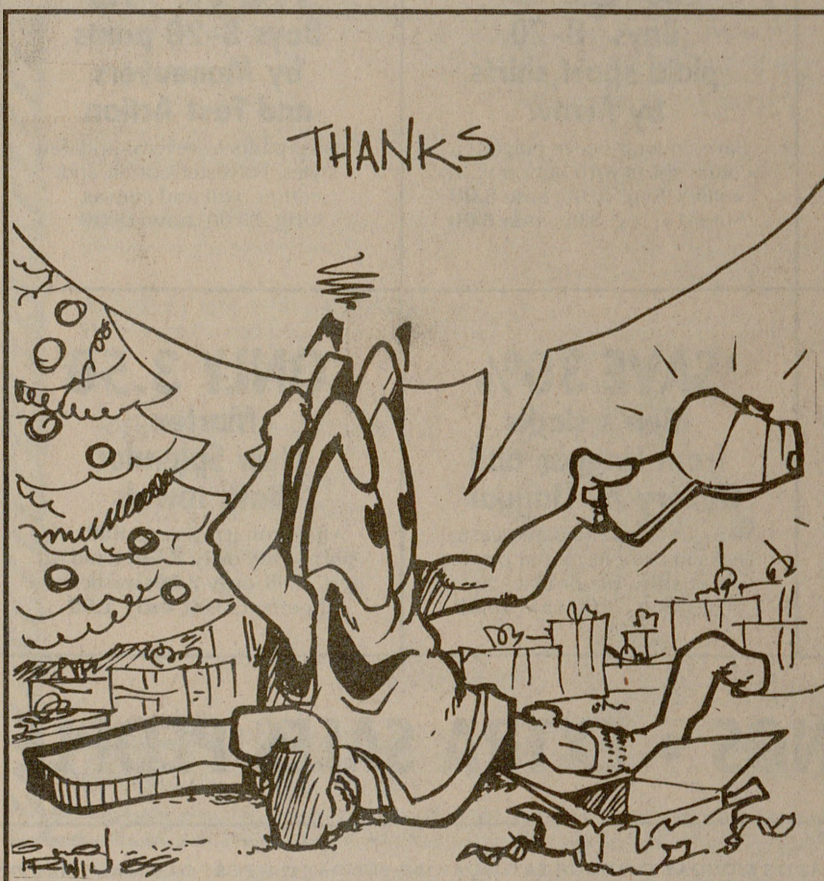
