company's "report card" is poor, word should be spread through the black community to cut off ties with that company, she said.

The 44-year-old Taylor said black spending power is over \$200 billion annually. She told the audience they must organize their economic power so as not to "empower those entities that would disempower us."

"There are two groups that I find in the most pain in our community; poor blacks and corporate blacks," she said.

Even though black people are qualified to be in the upper echelons of corporate America, they aren't there, Taylor said.

"It's not because we're not well-trained, it's not because we haven't burned the midnight oil, it's pure and simple racism," she said. "What black America needs is our own corporate America."

She credited much of her success to the habit of having quiet time alone. She told the audience to get in the habit of spending time with themselves each day for a period of self-questioning and evaluation.

"Each of us has a finite amount of time, but it's enough time to realize our dreams," she said. "But you don't even know what your dreams are if you don't take quiet time."

phers, the first anything you can put an 'ist' on the end of, such as scientists, have their origins in Egypt," he said. "Scholarship, excellence and leadership were spawned in the Nile Valley. Everything begins in Egypt and the Old Mec culture (of the Aztecs)."

"There is no science taught at A&M that was not started by a black man. Most of Einstein's ideas appear in African science and philosophy

seven centuries before Einstein. This is documented.

"There wasn't anything called advanced medicine in Europe prior to what the Asians and Africans discovered. The oldest medical books known to man... are from Africa."

"While it is important for blacks to know the history of their culture, it is equally important for them to pass on that knowledge.

"We allow Tone Loc to be the educator of our children," he said. "Tone Loc is talking about the 'Wild Thing.' We allow that to happen. We are the progenitors of knowledge. We allow other people to take control who don't even have the best interests of our children in mind."

After looking to their past, Anderson said African-American students must use their knowledge base to plan for their futures.

"Don't be deluded by data that might suggest you will be a success, when in fact, success is light years away," he said.

He cited a USA Today study that said there will be 70,000 jobs available to college graduates at the end

"The answer to any dilemma could ever face is inside of you. You don't take quiet time. You doubt yourself. It's during quiet time that you shore yourself up."

"I challenge you as I challenge myself. I challenge you to really as you climb."

Taylor began writing freelance for Essence in 1971, a year after she started a cosmetics company. She worked in a variety of positions; the magazine's staff before being named editor-in-chief in 1981. Since then, with four million subscribers, is celebrating its 20th anniversary this year.

Taylor emphasized the importance of African-American students knowing their history. Citing Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s efforts to secure freedom and Marcus Garvey's printing-press operation in 1919, she said, "The hardest work has been done, she said."

"We have made America, black men and women working side by side for over hundreds of years," said Taylor, who grew up in Harlem. "If you know your history, then you know you have strength. Stay rooted in your culture."

"We have lots of oars in the water. We have to make sure we use them. Pull smartly, and in the same direction."

"There is no time to waste time and be unfocused when there are only 70,000 jobs available," he said. "We're talking about hundreds of thousands of graduates wanting 70,000 jobs and you don't even have the diligence and persistence to study. Come on, who are you kidding?"

To prepare for the future, Anderson said students must demand resources they need to succeed in school and to attain a strong knowledge of their culture and history.

"You have the right to demand the structures on your campus that will address the diversity of students," he said. "You have the right to have all the structures available to you to help you attain academic excellence. Never refrain from making that demand because there was the first Hispanic and that first black person who got that degree from Texas A&M so you could be there right now."

Anderson summed up the need for knowledge with a Chinese proverb:

"A man who does not know, does not know that he does not know, is a fool. Stay away from him. A man who does not know, but thinks that he knows, is a charlatan. Be careful of him. He who does not know, but knows that he does not know, is a child. Teach him. He who knows, and knows that he knows, is a wise man. Sit at his feet and learn from him."

Anderson received his undergraduate degree in psychology from Villanova University and his Ph.D. from Cornell. He is currently a professor of psychology at Indiana University of Pennsylvania. He has received the Distinguished Black Alumni Award for 1987 from Villanova and the International Research Award from Dillard University for Cross-Cultural Research, and was selected for *Who's Who Among Black Americans*.
