# Judge lets jurors ask witnesses questions

CORPUS CHRISTI (AP) — Jurors in a capital murder trial are getting the opportunity to perform a task normally reserved for lawyers: a judge has let the jury ask questions of witnesses.

"I've been wanting to do this for over two years," said state District Judge Joaquin Villarreal, who on Tuesday began experimenting with the procedure used in some other states.

Villarreal warned the jurors Tuesday that some of their questions might not get asked. He told them not to get angry if that happened because the law dictates that the court follow certain rules.

The procedure adopted by Villarreal is patterned after one employed by judges in Milwaukee County, Wis., and publicized in the Jan. 29 edition of the National Law Journal.

After each witness was questioned in the conventional manner by the prosecution and defense attorneys, Villarreal asked jurors if they had any questions. The jury was sent out of the courtroom while their unsigned, handwritten questions were collected.

The questions were studied by the judge, Nueces County District Attorney Grant Jones and defense lawyer Jimenez. Both lawyers were given a chance to object to the questions, arguments were heard and the judge ruled on whether to allow the questions to be asked.

The jury was then brought back into the courtroom and Villarreal asked the approved questions.

was proper for a jury to question witnesses, and said there were no provisions in Texas law allowing it.

"I have problems with trying something new in a case of this importance," Jimenez said during a break in testimony.

Defendant Juan Hernandez, 25, faces death by injection or life in prison if convicted in connection with the March 29, 1988, slaying of Santos Briones, 74, of Corpus Christi.

held his post since 1967, said this is the first time he's heard of a judge in Texas allowing the jury to question witnesses.

# Bush proposes major cuts in Medicare

WASHINGTON (AP) — Deep cuts in Medicare spending proposed by President Bush could push more financially strapped hospitals to the edge of collapse in Texas, which leads the country in hospital failures, officials said Wednesday.

The president's budget for the fiscal year that begins Oct. 1 seeks a \$5.5 billion cut in Medicare, the government's health insurance program for the disabled and elderly.

According to Sen. Lloyd Bentsen, chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, 75 percent of the Medicare cuts, or \$4.1 billion, would come out of payments to hospitals for treating the elderly and disabled.

Congressional Democrats claim the proposed cuts, which mirror Bush's failed proposals for the current fiscal year, would be devastating to rural and inner city hospitals in Texas. For the past four years, that state has led the country in hospital failures. Comment from the administration was not immediately available.

The state's hospitals are struggling under this year's \$1 billion cut in Medicare reimbursements, officials said.
