Rep. warns run-off elections could delay early House vote on school finance reform

AUSTIN (AP) — A key state lawmaker and a business spokesman said Thursday they don't expect the House to vote on school finance reform before the April 10 run-off elections, but a spokesman for House Speaker Gib Lewis disagreed.

"I wouldn't expect that (an early vote), just based on my understanding of where the members are — or where they aren't," said Rep. Ric Williamson, vice-chairman of the budget-writing Appropriations Committee and a member of the tax-writing Ways and Means Committee.

There is no consensus on the best way to address a Texas Supreme Court ruling that the \$11 billion-a-year school finance system is unconstitutional, said Williamson, D-Weatherford. Lawmakers will tackle the issue in a 30-day special session beginning Tuesday.

If lawmakers still haven't reached some consensus before the March 13 primary elections and the April 10 run-offs — and if many are involved in run-off elections — Williamson said he wouldn't expect the issue to be put before the full House by then.

Bill Alloway, executive vice president of the business-oriented Texas Association of Taxpayers, said, "The report is that there will be no hard votes until after the run-off election."

But Tim Conger, spokesman for Speaker Lewis, said, "We categorically deny that that is the case. The speaker understands the gravity of the issues to be addressed."

The Supreme Court found glaring disparities between poorer and rich districts and has given the state until May 1 to reform a system, which relies on a combination of local property taxes and state aid. The elections make it politically sensitive to talk about a possible increase to help make the system constitutional.


Alloway said Williamson told a group in a speech last week that he was had assured the lawmaker that he wouldn't be any votes on constitutional issues before April 10. But Williamson said he was only giving an opinion, and that he hadn't spoken to Lewis or the speaker's staff about the matter.
