In Advance
Financial aid seminars scheduled
 The financial aid department at Texas A&M will host four seminars, Tuesday and Wednesday April 3-4 in 225 Pavilion.
 Don Engelage, director of financial aid at A&M, said the seminars will cover how aid is administered, how a student's financial need is determined and what ongoing requirements the student must meet. He said the satisfactory academic progress policy and the purpose of letters from academic advisers also will be addressed.
 The goal of the seminars is to relay information to faculty and staff, so they can relay it to students in need, Engelage said. Space is limited to 25 seats, so only faculty and staff are invited.
 He said the aid department has hosted these seminars the past three years. They have been received well and space fills up fast, he said.
 The department cannot open these seminars to students because the limited space will not permit it, he said. But the counselors in the department speak to dorm residents, other organizations on campus and churches, Engelage said. Financial problems are the last things students need to worry about, he said. Making the faculty and staff knowledgeable about the department and what it offers will help with helping students, Engelage said.
