

Financial aid seminars scheduled

The financial aid department at Texas A&M will host four seminars, Tuesday and Wednesday April 3-4 in 225 Pavilion.

Don Engelage, director of fi-nancial aid at A&M, said the seminars will cover how aid is ad-ministered, how a student's financial need is determined and what ongoing requirements the student must meet.
