## Fraternity to celebrate 125 years of existence

The Texas A&M chapter of Al-pha Tau Omega will celebrate the 125th anniversary of the founding of its national fraternity at 8 tonight at the Hilton Hotel, 801 University

first ATO chapter was founded Sept. 11, 1865 and was one of the first fraternities to be organized in the South after the Civil

Dwayne Bohac, president of A&M's chapter, says the fraternity plans to combine the anniversary celebration with its fall 1990 pledge

## Child pornography investigation leads to arrest of state employee

HALTOM CITY (AP) —An investigation of alleged child pornography and child sexual assaults at a house here has led to a third arrest—that of a former Texas attorney general's office employee.

Gordon Clive Blevins remained jailed Wednesday on \$150,000 bond on charges of aggravated sexual assault of a child and sexual performance of a child.

He is accused of fondling and videotaping a nude 12-year-old boy at the house in this Fort Worth suburb. Two other men who live at the house were arrested last week on

child sexual assault charges. One of the men, William Thomas Fultz, 41, told police he has AIDS. The other man, Fredrick Charles Olsen, 33, is Blevins' nephew. Fultz has been charged with inde-

cency with a child, and Olsen has been charged with sexual assault of a child.

Blevins, 45, was asked to resign as an administrative technician the same day his nephew was arrested, but a spokesman said Tuesday there is no connection between the arrest

and the resignation. Haltom City police Lt. Ron Hewitt "One of the men did a bunch of talking, plus a bunch of the people involved (the victims) did a bunch of

talking," Hewitt said. "We're looking at possibly two more men. It's grow-

ing every day."

The investigation is focused on the residence, where police allege young males were promised money and clothing in exchange for sexual

Since August, about eight male victims have told police they were fondled and watched pornographic videotapes there.

Police raided the house Aug. 28, arresting Olsen and Fultz and confiscating 73 videotapes.

It was unclear Tuesday how many

of the tapes, if any, contained pornographic material, Tarrant County District Attorney Tim Curry said. Blevins was hired in May 1988 at

the attorney general's office, where he worked as an administrative technician in the workers compensation department, said Ron Dusek, a spokesman for the state agency.

His job entailed traveling to state agencies and setting up safety procedures for state employees, Dusek

According to Curry, Blevins oversaw programs at about 40 agencies, including state hospitals and youth centers.

BRIEF EXPLANATORY STATEMENT OF PROPOSED

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT GENERAL ELECTION **NOVEMBER 6, 1990** 

PROPOSITION NO. 1 ON THE BALLOT

Senate Joint Resolution 2, Sixth Called Session, 71st Legislatur proposes a constitutional amendment to provide that if the Senate, any special session, does not take final action to confirm or reje an appointee of the Governor made during a recess of the Senate, the appointee is entitled to continue in office until the Senate rejects the appointee at a subsequent session or until the Governor appoint another person to fill the vacancy, but such a nominee whom Senate does not act to confirm or reject at a subsequent regula session is considered to be rejected when the session ends.

The proposed amendment will appear on the ballot as follows:

"The constitutional amendment to clarify the authority of the senate to consider certain nominees to state and district offices and to provide for filling vacancies in those offices."
