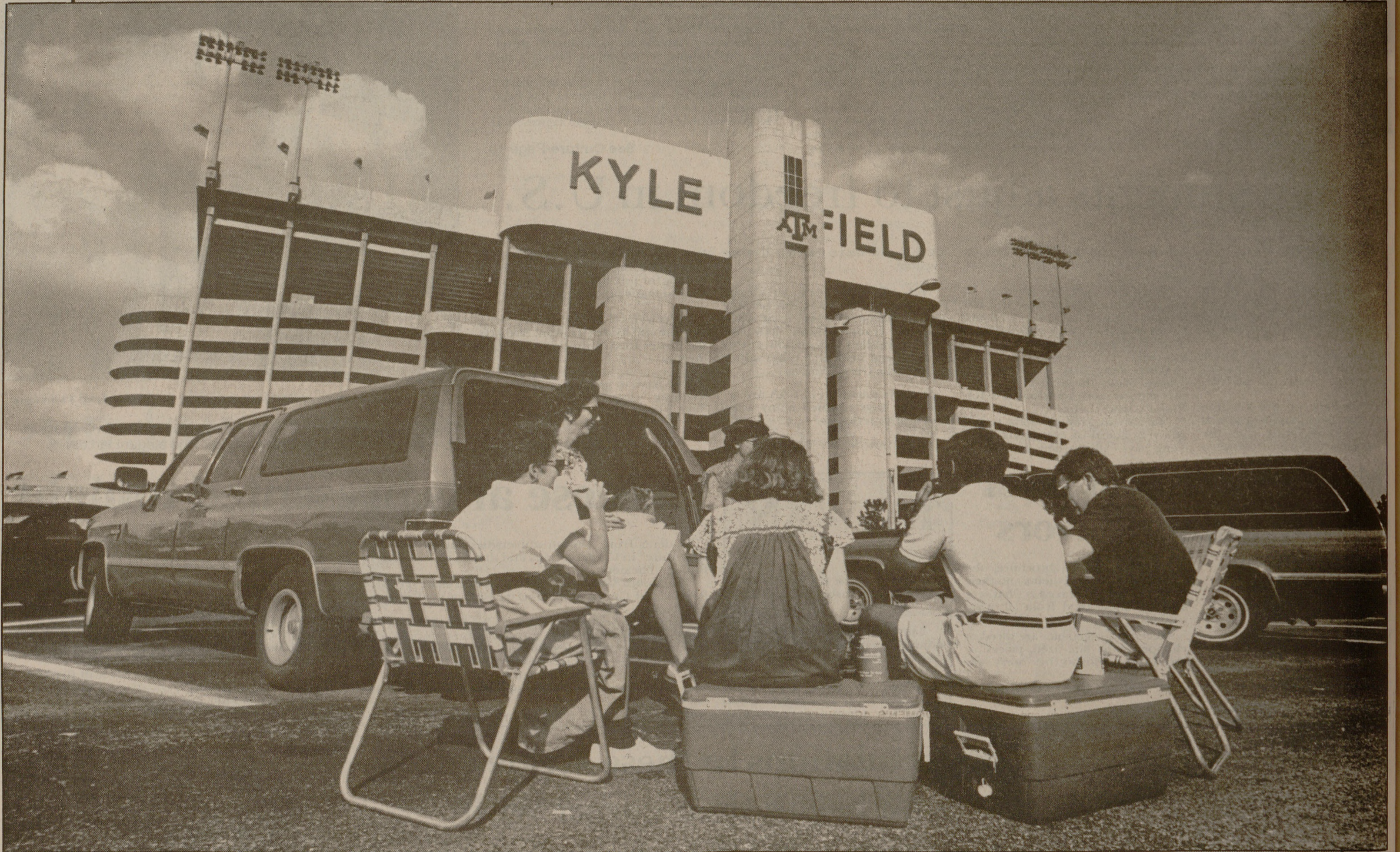

# 'Tis the Season

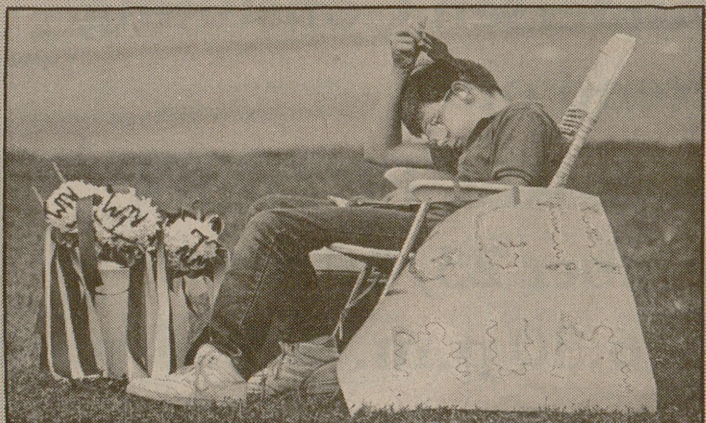


Before each home game, the parking lot in front of Kyle Field is filled with loyal fans preparing for a successful Aggie homestand by drinking their favorite libations. The

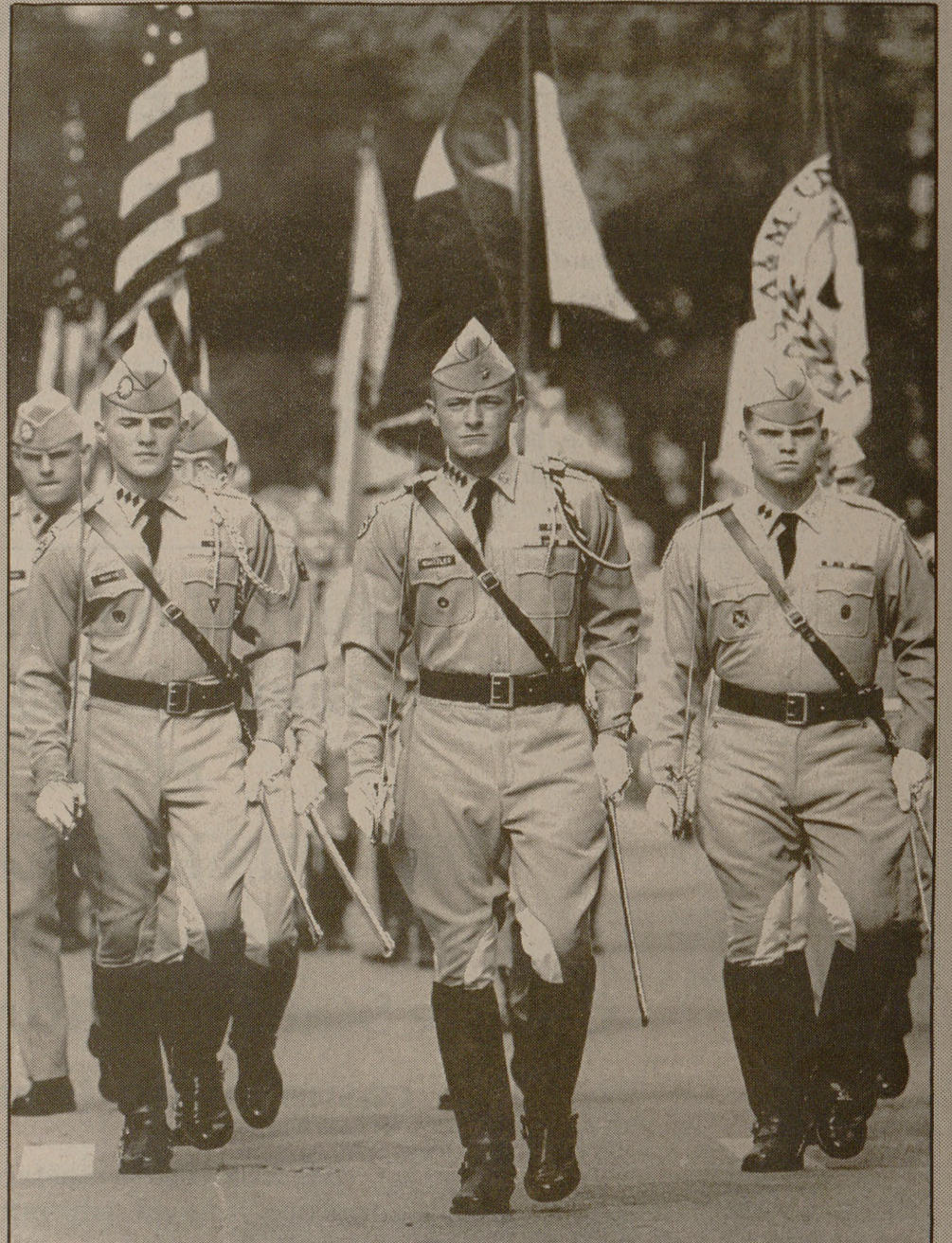
