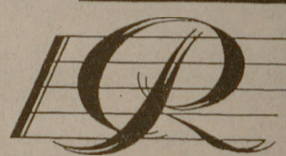

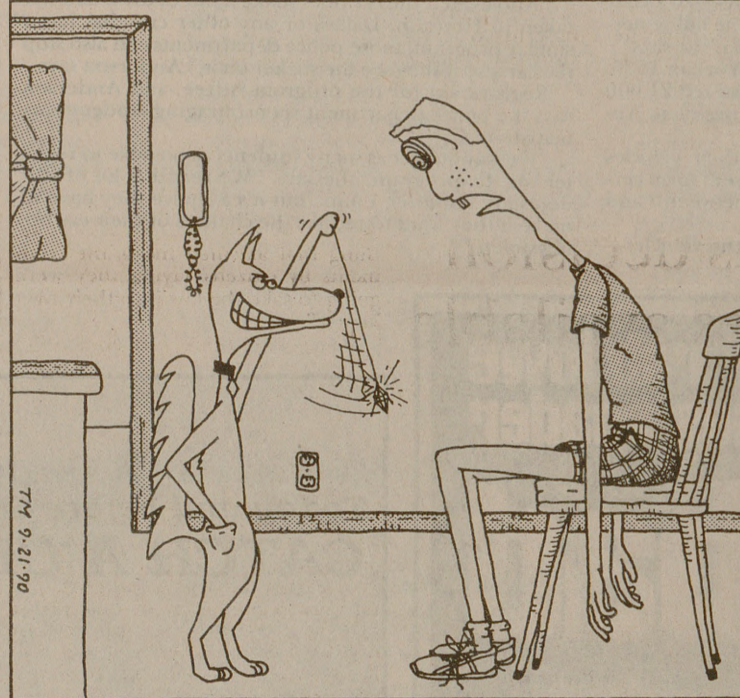

Slain trooper remembered as valorous

WEBSTER (AP) - Nearly 1,000 mourners, including hundreds of police officers, crammed into a Houston-area church Thursday to pay final respects to slain rookie Department of Public Safety Officer Mark Phebus. Phebus, 23, was gunned down early Monday in Montgomery County when he stopped at what he believed was a traffic accident but really was a domestic disturbance. A 43-year-old Spring man, Richard Leland Jordan, is charged with capital murder and remains at large. Several hundred Texas troopers were joined by officers from as far away as the Dallas area and Louisiana for services at the NASA Church of the Nazarene in suburban Houston. Phebus' casket was draped with a Texas flag and flanked by an honor guard of troopers. Mourners attending Thursday's service walked through a line of state troopers that bordered the road leading into the church. "The senseless and tragic way he died is beyond our understanding," Wayne Hicks, pastor of the church, told mourners. "It just doesn't make sense." Hicks said Phebus had been taught Christian values at home and wanted his life to mean something. "He chose to live a life of serving others," he said, noting that if Phebus had not stopped at the rural Montgomery County scene early Monday, Jordan's wife might have been killed. "Mark's life was not dedicated to the safe way," he said. "Mark died a man of honor and valor. I pray his spirit will live on with all of us."

A longtime friend, Beverly Stanton, who attended Southern Nazarene University in Bethany, Okla., with him, remembered Phebus as always friendly and willing to lend a hand. "He was a good and wonderful man with a lot of heart," she said. At the service, she read a letter from a motorist identified as Bobby Presley, who had received a ticket from Phebus on April 24 but felt compelled to write to Phebus' superiors about the trooper's conduct. "Mr. Phebus treated me with courtesy and respect," the motorist wrote. Phebus was off-duty and returning from College Station when he saw a ditched car and stopped to help. After approaching the couple, he was shot in the face. Authorities said Jordan allegedly had chased his estranged wife, Janet, from a bar in Pinehurst where the couple had an argument. The woman, who has been helping police, said her husband was drunk and had vowed to kill someone before the night was over.
