Slain trooper remembered as valorous

WEBSTER (AP) — Nearly 1,000 mourners, including hundreds of police officers, crammed into a Houston-area church Thursday to pay final respects to slain rookie De-partment of Public Safety Officer Mark Phebus.

Phebus, 23, was gunned down early Monday in Montgomery

County when he stopped at what he believed was a traffic accident but really was a domestic disturbance.

A 43-year-old Spring man, Rich-

ard Leland Jordan, is charged with capital murder and remains at large.

Several hundred Texas troopers were joined by officers from as far away as the Dallas area and Louisiana for services at the NASA Church of the Nazarene in suburban Houston.

Phebus' casket was draped with a Texas flag and flanked by an honor guard of troopers. Mourners attending Thursday's service walked through a line of state troopers that bordered the road leading into the church.




