Police seek information on thefts

Brazos County Crime Stoppers is seeking information about two thefts at the Wilson Cattle Company on Old San Antonio Road.

Eight Dunlop retread truck tires were stolen July 30 after thieves cut the lock and chain which secured them. The second theft occurred Aug. 15 when thieves stole a Campbell-Hausfeld air compressor and a saddle. The stolen items are estimated to






