
## Young linebacker lives dream Pa starts in Austin against Texas

Texas A&M linebacker Jason Atkinson already knew this was going to be a busy week

With two civil engineering tests. including one at 8 a.m. the morning after Bonfire, Atkinson had enough to deal with before having to worry about shutting down the Texas of-

But when Anthony Williams, the Aggies' leading tackler, went down with a torn groin last week against

Texas Christian, Atkinson suddenly found himself with another task.

With Williams doubtful and sophomore Trent Lewis out with a knee injury, Atkinson, a redshirt fresh-man from Houston Westfield, will start in the one game he's dreamed about all his life

"It's always been one of my dreams to play Texas in Memorial Stadium," Atkinson said. "I'm a third-generation Aggie and I've been coming to games at Kyle Field since I was two. The first full song I ever learned was probably the (Aggie) War Hymn.'






