

FOXBORO, Mass. (AP) — Michael Timpson denied newspaper quoted Fraley as saying.

Fraley said he would meet with Mowatt next week, according to the Boston Globe.

"We will go before whatever forum necessary to see that justice is done here. We are going to look at every reasonable basis to proceed legally in this case," the
