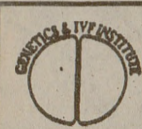

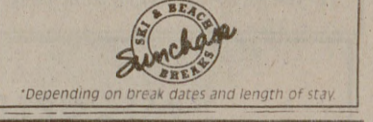

first term should be arriving soon.
Dr. Irene Hoadley, director of the Sterling C. Evans Library, received the first batch of documents Dec. 31, and is not sure how many more boxes will come.
The University has received about 500 boxes containing documents, but most of them still have to be processed, counted and catalogued.
Schultz says processing such a large collection is expensive and the library lacks the funds for materials and staff.
The library probably will process

files most useful to researchers first and make those papers available before any other documents, she says.
Hoadley says she believes the papers possibly have great educational potential.
"A&M students can learn about the development of the Republican party in Texas because Clements was the first Republican governor since the Reconstruction," she says.
Mobley agrees. "He (Clements) obviously thinks well of A&M and recognizes we are a comprehensive University," he says.

Hoadley says she is pleased the University acquired the collection.
"We hope it will be an incentive for other officials to donate their papers, so we can build an archive of modern politics," she says.
Clements is the highest-ranking official who has donated documents to the University, but the A&M collection also includes papers from former Texas House Speaker Billy Clayton, Class of '51, former State Sen. Kent Caperton, Class of '71, and U.S. Rep. Joe Barton.

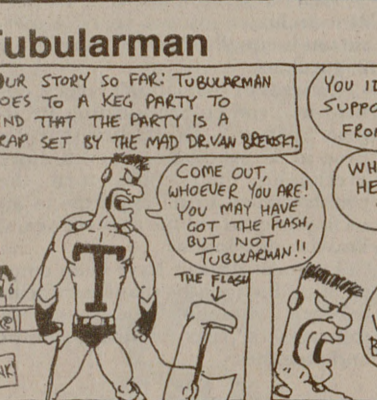

Richmond says a person must attend an orientation session to apply for any MSC position.
"There is an orientation session

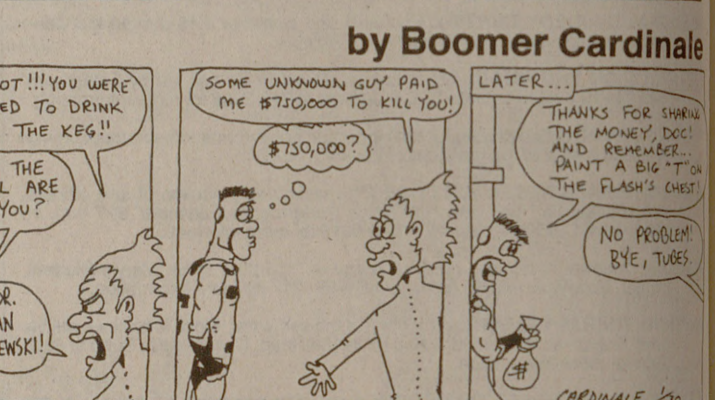
prior to each of the rounds," she says.
"It's in their best interests to attend one of those, so they can have a feel for the process and understand the requirements of the position."
Altendorf says position descriptions are available from the Student Programs Office secretaries, Browning Library and Print 'N' Copy.

Candidates also can speak with present MSC officers, Altendorf says.
"This year we're trying to be more objective in the selections, more quantitative," he says. "Part of the nominating committee will sit down with all individuals and talk through the process. That way it will help them in the future."
