## Voters initiate recall election

BROWNSVILLE (AP) - Three city commissioners known as the "Three Amigos" re the target of a recall drive by Brownsville The deputy commissioners, Butch Barbosa, a liam Garza, an accountant; and Court; Wilvides, who owns a driving school, make up a majority vote on the five-member council. The recall movement was ignited by the privatization of the city's sanitation department and an unsuccessful effort by the tion center without voter approval.
"This is a grassroots movement, the muscle is there to get them out, and we will do it eventually," said Pat Ahumada, a business-

The Brownsville city charter allows a recall election if one-fourth of the registered voters request it. Ahumada said he has
4,000 of the 10,000 signatures he needs to force the election.
The recall drive is the second under way on the Texas-Mexico border. In Donna, efforts are afoot to recall Mayor Hector Ca
Barbosa and Benavides were elected in November 1989 and formed an alliance with Garza, who was elected in 1987. Early last
