**Mobil clears way for scholarships**

The first priority for the award of Mobil scholarships will be to the spouses and children of U.S. servicemen and women who lost their lives while on active duty during Operation Desert Storm, Murray explained.

Personnel who served during that period in the Middle East are next on the priority list, followed by personnel on active duty in places other than the Middle East. Spouses and children of those who served on active military duty during that time also are eligible for the award.

A&M President William Mobley said the servicemen and women returning to A&M will benefit greatly from the scholarship.

"It is indeed a fitting tribute to the men and women who so gallantly served in our armed forces during that crucial period," Mobley said.

Scholarships will be awarded to full-time students pursuing undergraduate degrees, Murray explained.

Recipients will be selected by University officials on the basis of personal achievement and academic performance, he said.

Murray said the grants would supplement, not replace, federal or state financial resources for which a Mobil Scholar also might be eligible.

A&M is one of 20 universities, including eight in Texas, receiving the special Mobil gifts.
