Green Week Tips

The Battalion will offer its readers suggestions this week on ways to make our planet available for the next generation. This service coincides with the Texas Environmental Action Coalition's "Green Week."

The following tips focus on water conservation:

- Install a water-saving showerhead.
- Take showers rather than baths.
- Install sink faucet aerators.
- Turn off the water between rinses when shaving and brushing teeth.
- Use a broom rather than hose to wash walkways.
- Don't let the hose run when you wash your car.
- Wash your car with a bucket of soapy water.
- Water plants and lawn in the morning to minimize evaporation.
- Install a drip irrigation watering system.
- Plant drought-tolerant plants.

Grand jury investigates state representative

AUSTIN (AP) — State Rep. Hugo Berlanga received \$27,000 from a Houston company with ties to a San Antonio law firm whose relationship with lawmakers has been the focus of grand jury scrutiny, a newspaper reported.

The Dallas Morning News reported in its early Tuesday editions that a Travis County grand jury is investigating the accusations, detailed in part in a lawsuit filed by Ken Gray and John Kalisek Jr. The two are former employees of Federal Civil Process Inc.

Gray testified two weeks ago before the grand jury, and Kalisek appeared Friday under subpoena.

Last week, Berlanga was fined \$500 and held in contempt of court for refusing to turn over his business records sought by the grand jury.
