Ryan powers Rangers' win

PORT CHARLOTTE, Fla. (AP) — Nolan Ryan gave up five hits and two runs in seven innings and Geno Petralli hit the game-winning home run in the bottom of the 12th inning, leading the Texas Rangers to a 5-4 victory over the Toronto Blue Jays.

Ryan, whose final pre-season tune-up comes next week when he pitches against son Reid at the University of Texas, walked three and struck out seven.

Ryan walked Joe Carter leading off the seventh before John Olerud tripled in the Blue Jays first run. Olerud scored on Randy Knorr's sacrifice fly.

"Everything's pretty much on schedule," Ryan said. "I had better stuff today than I did the last time out. I pretty much did what I set out to do down here."

Petralli, who didn't hit a home run in 325 at-bats last season and 386 trips to the plate overall, connected off Frank Wills with two outs in the 12th. His last regular season homer came off Boston's Mike Boddicker on June 20, 1989.

The Rangers tied the score in the bottom of the ninth on a two-out, two-run homer by newly-acquired Denny Walling, also off Wills.

Texas tied the game at 2-2 in the bottom of the seventh on a single by Jeff Huson and sacrifice fly by Kevin Reimer.
