SMU gives charter to gay group

DALLAS (AP) — Southern Methodist University's student senate has granted a charter to a gay and lesbian group for the first time, eight years after it first considered the issue.

After more than two hours of impassioned speeches, Bible citations and sometimes bitter attacks, the senate voted Tuesday to charter the Gay and Lesbian Student Organization. The charter approval allows the group to become eligible for year for university funding. SMU administrators had remained neutral as the debate heated this spring, but said they would stand by the senate's decision.

"I had no idea what was going to happen," said Kelly Hill, one of the leaders of the group. "I was really pleased with the rational discussion for the most part. I think this is going to project a very positive image for SMU."

Many colleges recognized gay and lesbian groups years ago, but some SMU students and faculty doubted their campus would ever join the trend.

Opponents of the charter complained that the senate failed to follow the will of most students.

"I think we've seen a public atrocity here," said Kelly Hill, Evans, chairman of the Christian Republicans and an SMU member. "I think the senators did not the way their constituents wanted them to vote."
