Arms sales to Mideast continue

WASHINGTON (AP) - The Bush administration announced new Persian Gulf arms deals Tuesday and Defense Secretary Dick Cheney said President Bush's plea for Middle East arms control does not mean America will stop supplying the region's weapons.

"We simply cannot fall into the trap of ... (saying) that arms control means we don't provide any arms to the Middle East," Cheney told reporters aboard his plane as he returned to Washington from a 10-day trip to Europe, Israel and Egypt.

A senior Defense Department official, speaking on the condition of anonymity, said the administration had agreed to sell 20 Apache attack helicopters to the United Arab Emirates and as many as six unspecified military helicopters to





key legislation, such as civil rights and a crime bill. "We are going to miss his wisdom and his support," Bush said. Thornburgh, a two-term former

Pennsylvania governor, was an original member of Bush's Cab-Thornburgh would not stay in office if he became the party's offi-

cial candidate, said a Thornburgh political associate, who spoke on condition of anonymity.

"If he is a candidate for Senate, he will not be the attorney gener-al," the associate said. "If he becomes a candidate, it will be when his party nominates him."
