Slovenia and the federal presidency accused each other of jeopardizing the peace accord, even before a European Community team arrived Tuesday to mediately."

"I have been extremely fortunate; I have benefited greatly from the civil rights movement, from the justice for whom I am nominated to succeed," Thomas said of civil rights groups and Justice Thurgood Marshall, the first black member of the high court. Marshall is retiring at age

Thomas, 43, made the remarks during a courtesy call on Sen. Strom Thurmond, R-S.C., in a clear response to charges by some civil rights leaders that he learned the wrong lessons from his long climb out of a childhood of poverty in segregated



Republic leaders endorse program

MOSCOW (AP) — President Mikhail S. Gorbachev won crucial endorsement from Russian President Boris Yeltsin and eight other republic leaders Monday for the economic program he will present to Western leaders in London.

Efforts to build a market economy got a boost earlier Monday from lawmakers, who voted 343-5 to give preliminary approval to the Soviets' first bankruptcy law. The republics' endorsement, reached in talks at black family in the segregated a plush government country home 12 miles west of Moscow, was sure to boost Gorbachev's stand-

ing at his meeting July 17 with leaders of the Group of Seven most industrialized nations.

Republic officials "agreed to the arguments proposed by Gorbachev to the problems which will be discussed in London," the state-run TV newscast "Vremya" reported.

"A big concord was achieved, and I'm leaving not only with my own ideas and impressions, but also with a common position of all participants in this process," Gorbachev told "Vremya."

"It came out here that we can solve all problems more successfully if we remember that we have been formed as one powerful economic market."


