

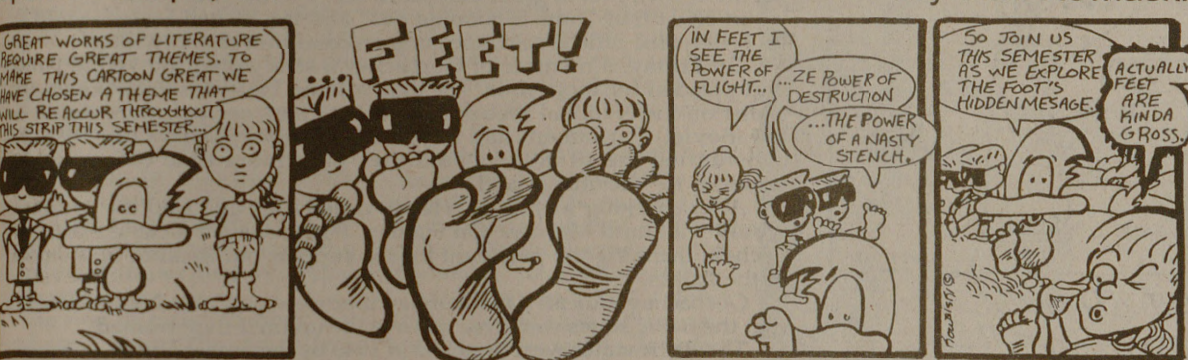

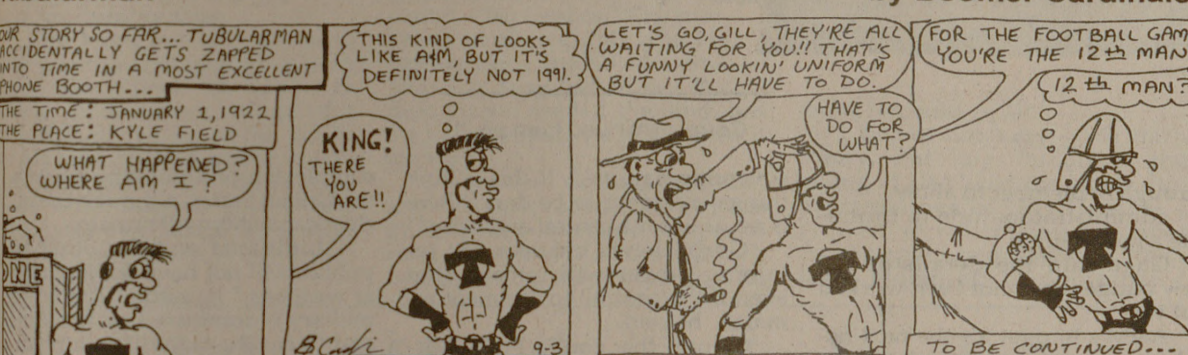

Pilot survives plane crash in Kansas

BAAZAR, Kan. (AP) — The pilot of a plane that crashed and burned in Chase County Monday was in critical condition at the University of Kansas Medical Center.

The pilot, Dale R. Opitz, 67, of Amarillo, Texas, reached the Kansas Turnpike about a quarter-mile west of the crash site and flagged down a motorist for help.

Dispatcher Suzanne Asbridge of the Turnpike Authority said the motorist took Opitz to Newman Hospital in Emporia. Opitz suffered severe burns and was in critical condition after being transferred to the University of Kansas Medical Center in Kansas City.

Woman charged with running over husband

SAN ANTONIO (AP) — A woman accused of running her husband down with her car in a nightclub parking lot was charged Monday with murder.

Rosemary Grover, 30, was being held at the Bexar County Jail in the death of her husband, Ruben Farias, 29, said San Antonio Police Sergeant Mike Akeroyd.

Farias was walking through the crowded parking lot of the Reflex nightclub in northwest San Antonio about 2:15 a.m. Monday when he was run down.

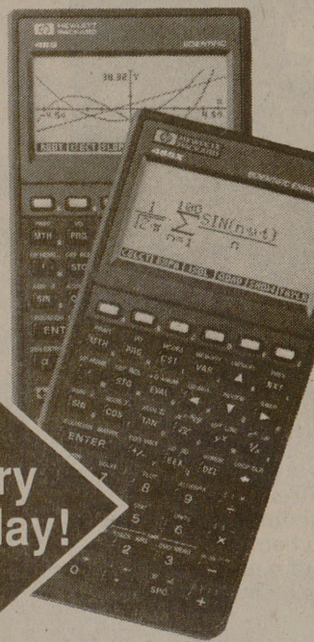

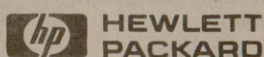

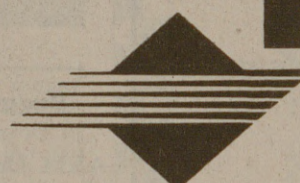
