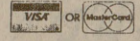

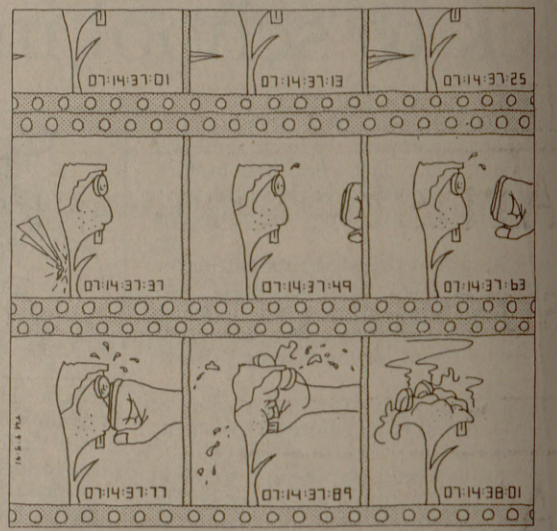

### Jordan

Ten students are selected as Jordan Fellows each year after completing an application and interviewing process.

"These students are given grants to pursue a self-designed research project abroad," she said.

One Jordan Fellow is doing a two-week seminar in Egypt this year, Altendorf said. The student will be doing underwater archeology on the Nile.

The Living Abroad Program offers an opportunity for students to live with host families in other countries and work in a job related to their career interests, Bonnen said. The visit lasts four to five weeks and can be in Germany or the Dominican Republic.

"One mechanical engineering major worked for Mercedes in Germany," she said. "It is a great experience and an opportunity to get a grasp of the language and the culture."

The Institute also maintains the MSC Jordan Collection, in the student center, which is set up like a museum and houses articles and gifts given to the Jordans by international dignitaries, Altendorf said.

"Most of these gifts were collected by the Jordans while they lived in Venezuela and Kuwait," he said.

Bonnen said the Institute uses these avenues to promote cultural awareness to the Aggie population.

"There are other groups on campus that emphasize the social issues going on in other countries," she said. "We're different because we deal with the cultural aspect of international awareness."

The Institute was established five years ago through an endowment set up by Jessie W. Jordan, memory and honor of her husband, Leland T. Jordan, Class of '29.

The Institute's emphasis on international culture is a tribute to Leland T. Jordan, for whom it is named. Jordan, born in Lufkin, 1906, graduated from A&M with a mechanical engineering degree in 1929.

He traveled to Venezuela as a production engineer for Gulf Oil Corporation. Three years later, he was managing and directing the Kuwait Oil Company, Ltd. from by Gulf Oil and British Petroleum.

In recognition of his service, British interests in Kuwait have appointed Honorary Commander of the order of the British Empire in 1958 and Honorary Knight of the Most Excellent Order in 1960 by Queen Elizabeth II. Jordan died in 1976.
