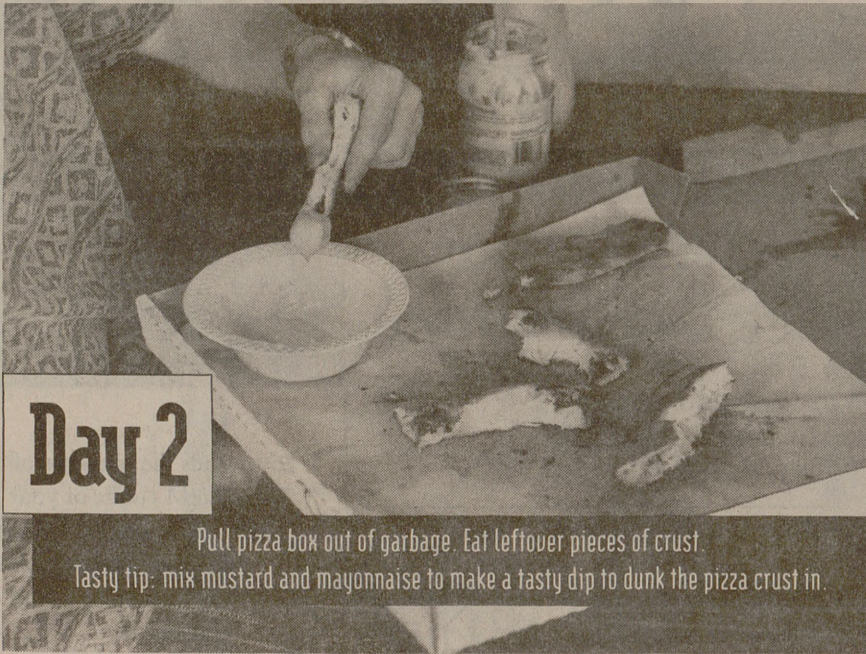


How To Survive On A Pizza For Three Days.



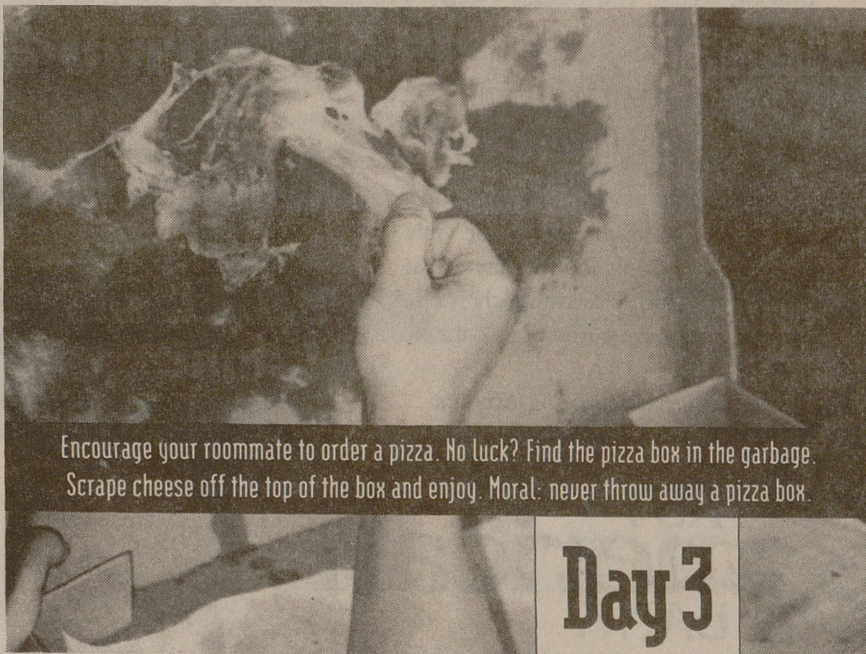
Day 1

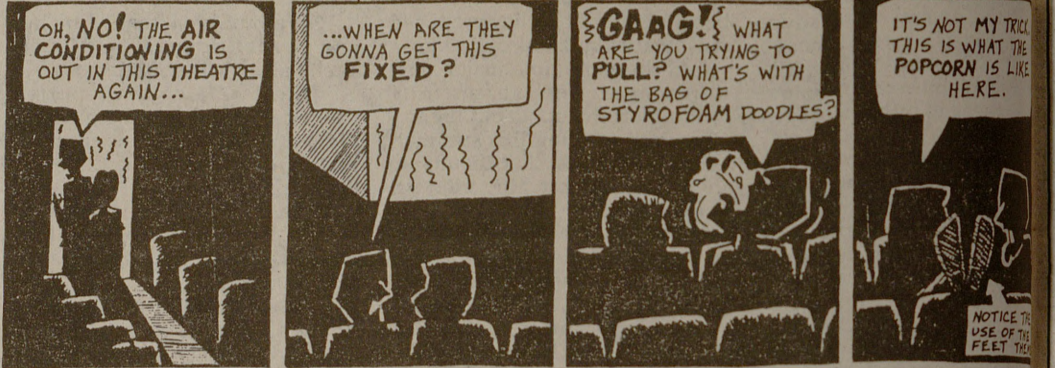

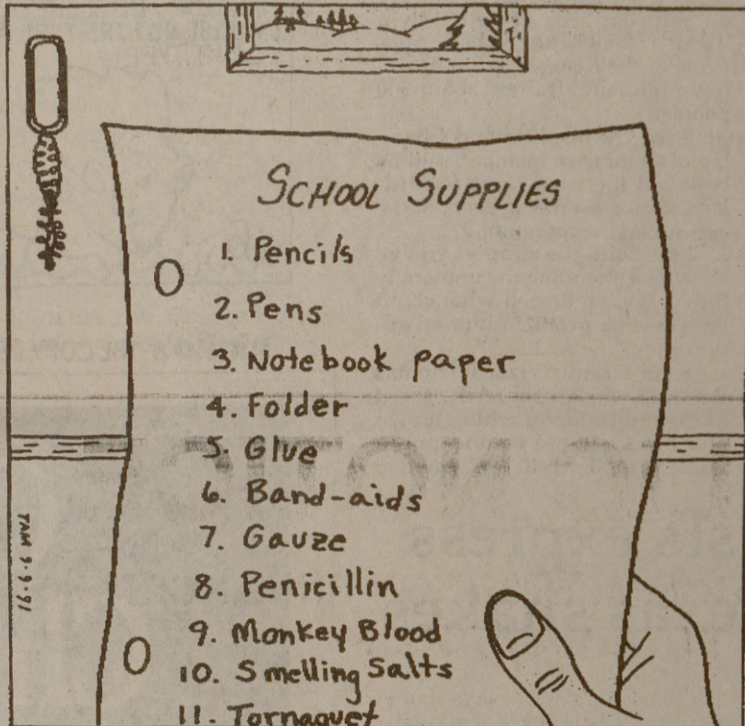

Encephalitis outbreak

HOUSTON (AP) - Mosborne St. Louis Encephalitis claimed the life of a 25-year-old man, bringing to six the number of confirmed cases of the brain infection in Harris County this year, health officials said.

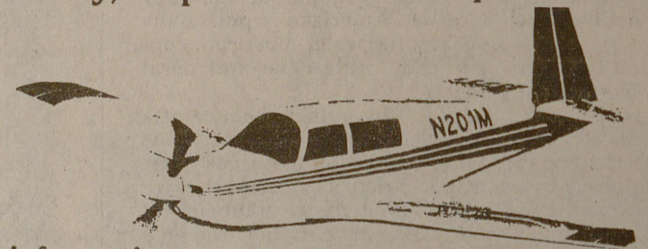
Officials on Saturday reported three new confirmed cases of four suspected cases of the disease, which is caused by a virus transmitted by the barely discernible bite of certain mosquitoes.

An inflammation of the brain, encephalitis has many symptoms but sometimes none appear. The most common symptoms are fever, headache, a stiff neck, lethargy, extreme sleepiness, sometimes disorientation or loss of coordination, convulsions and coma.

Rose Lee Bell, chief of epidemiology for Houston's health department, said the dead man had come ill in early August and died last week in a Houston hospital.
