# Iranian support sought

PARIS (AP) — U.N. Secretary General Javier Perez de Cuellar will travel to Tehran on Tuesday to seek Iranian help in winning the freedom of Western hostages in Lebanon.

"I'm going to see if I can obtain the Iranians' support," Perez de Cuellar told reporters after meeting Monday with French Foreign Minister Roland Dumas.

"By that, I don't wish to say that the Iranians are responsible, but even so, they have influences which could be useful for me in trying to resolve the problem of the Western hostages, as well as the detainees held in south Lebanon and the missing people on the Israeli side."

Lebanon's state-run news agency said an Iranian Foreign Ministry official, Mohammad Kazem Assad Khonsari, met in Beirut on Monday with Lebanese President Elias Hrawi and delivered a message from Iranian President Hashemi Rafsanjani. The contents were not revealed, but it was believed to be related to the hostage issue.
