Most of the grants offered provide round-trip transportation, tuition and maintenance for one academic year; a few provide international travel only, or a stipend intended as a partial grant-in-aid.





Jean Raniseski, assistant to the dean for the College of Liberal Arts and coordinator for undergraduate studies, said that because Liberal Arts students were not previously restricted concerning Q-drops, they will be allowed three drops beginning this semester.
