

## Moms-to-be will receive gift bags from commission

AUSTIN (AP) - Pregnant women who get health clinic checkups will receive a bag of gifts for themselves and their baby under a program announced Tuesday by the Texas Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse.

The campaign is aimed at increasing prenatal care and reducing the number of babies born with problems from maternal use of tobacco, drugs and alcohol during pregnancy, TCADA officials said.

"Babies born to mothers who do not receive prenatal care are much more likely to be born prematurely, have low birth weights or other serious health problems," said acting Health Commissioner Dr. Robert MacLean.

"Yet it is a sad fact that about one in three pregnant women in Texas receives inadequate or no prenatal care in this state at this time," he said.
