School bus victims' families sue Mission ISD

MISSION (AP) — The families of several students killed in 1989 when a school bus plunged into a water-filled pit are suing the Mission School District for negligence. The families say in 14 lawsuits that the district was negligent in not buying school buses with emergency exits and failing to train students and drivers in emergency evacuation procedures. Assistant Superintendent Robert Wicks said board members were disappointed by the lawsuits, noting the district had tried to help the victims and their families. "We've been very supportive," Wicks said. "Our principals and our counselors rode the buses with the students for a time after the incident." Twenty-one students were killed and 60 others injured morning of Sept. 21, 1989, when a soft drink delivery truck smashed into the bus and sent it plunging into a water-filled caliche pit in Alton. Truck driver Ruben Paez, who worked for Valley Coca-Cola Bottling Co., was charged with counts of involuntary manslaughter and is awaiting trial in District Court.

Calls for AIDS information dwindle

calls right after Magic Johnson made his announcement, mostly from students at A&M," Horner said. "A lot of the students were calling for research purposes. "Most people call wanting to know the difference between HIV and AIDS and the different ways to contract it," she said. "The interest is starting to slack off." Spokespersons at St. Joseph Hospital said interest in HIV has been low, even with Johnson's announcement. The number of calls has been very low, with callers asking for information on support groups. In interviews after his announcement, Johnson has said he contracted the virus from unprotected heterosexual sex. Johnson has not developed AIDS, but the HIV virus is considered to be a precursor of the disease. Horner said despite the decline in interest in HIV, the recent publicity has had positive effects. "The biggest thing this done is heighten the awareness of the general population," she said. "It's always regrettable when someone contracts HIV, but Johnson has brought the reality of heterosexuals can get HIV in the forefront of the public's mind. "His openness and candor has been an example to everyone," she said. "He's letting people know it's OK to get help."
