

In case you missed it . . .

Semester break full of A&M football, basketball news

The following article is a look back on the people and events at Texas A&M that made news during the semester break.

December 20, 1991

Texas A&M freshman Kevin Barker quit the men's basketball team for personal reasons. Barker, a 6-foot-9 forward from Longview, had played in five games for the Aggies, starting in three. He averaged 9.6 points and 2.4 rebounds per game.

January 1, 1992

A&M lost to Florida State University 10-2 in the 56th Mobil Cotton Bowl Classic in Dallas. The Aggies recorded a school and Cotton Bowl record eight turnovers in the drizzly New Year's Day game.

"Those things happen," said A&M head football coach R. C. Slocum after the game. "We've been pretty good, real good, in the turnover department. It was one of those days. I felt like as breaks go, we didn't get a lot of breaks in the game."

A&M senior linebacker Quentin Coryatt sacked Florida St. quarterback Casey Weldon for a safety in the first quarter to record the Aggies' lone score.

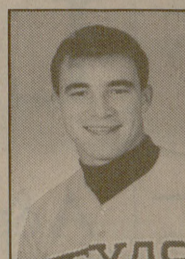
January 2, 1992

A&M (10-2) finishes the season ranked 12th in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and 13th in the USA Today Coaches' Poll.

January 4, 1992

A&M quarterback Jeff Granger

announced his decision to quit football and concentrate on his baseball career. Granger will pitch for the A&M baseball team. The 1992 season begins Feb. 3 against Stephen F. Austin in Nacogdoches.



regarded as one of the nation's top freshmen, averaging 16.8 points and 8.8 rebounds in 13 games. "It's unfortunate for Dama because he had a great chance to be freshman of the year in the Southwest Conference," Barone said. "It's a tough blow for us, but hopefully it will give some of the other kids an opportunity to step in and produce."

January 7, 1992

Senior Shedrick Anderson was reinstated to the A&M basketball team. The 6-foot-8 forward was suspended before fall practice for violating team rules.

Anderson scored 15 points the same night in a loss to TCU.

January 11, 1992

Senior safety Chris Crooms participates in the Hula Bowl in Hawaii while Slocum, Richardson and Coryatt take part in the Japan Bowl in Tokyo.

January 14, 1992

The A&M men's basketball team loses to Texas, 76-73, its sixth consecutive loss. Five of the Aggies' ten losses this season have been by less than six points. A&M is 3-10, 0-3 in the SWC.

January 16, 1992

A&M men's coach Tony Barone announced that freshman Damon Johnson will miss four to six weeks because of a fractured third metatarsal in his left foot.



January 20, 1992

The A&M women's basketball team won its first game in 14 years over the University of Texas in Austin. Dena Russo's last second layup lifted the Lady Aggies to a 74-73 win, A&M's sixth straight.

The Lady Aggies are 12-5, 4-1 in the conference. They play Rice Owls this Saturday in Houston at 7 p.m.

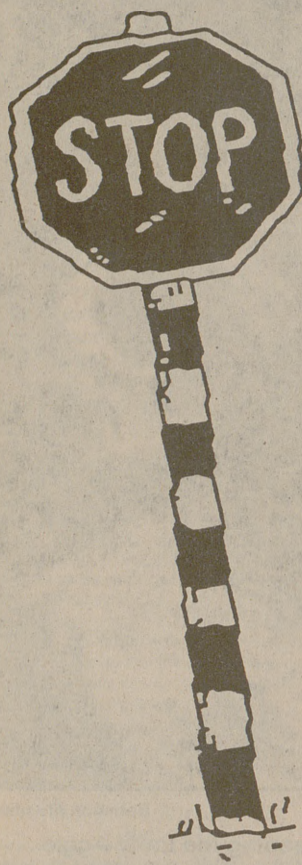
