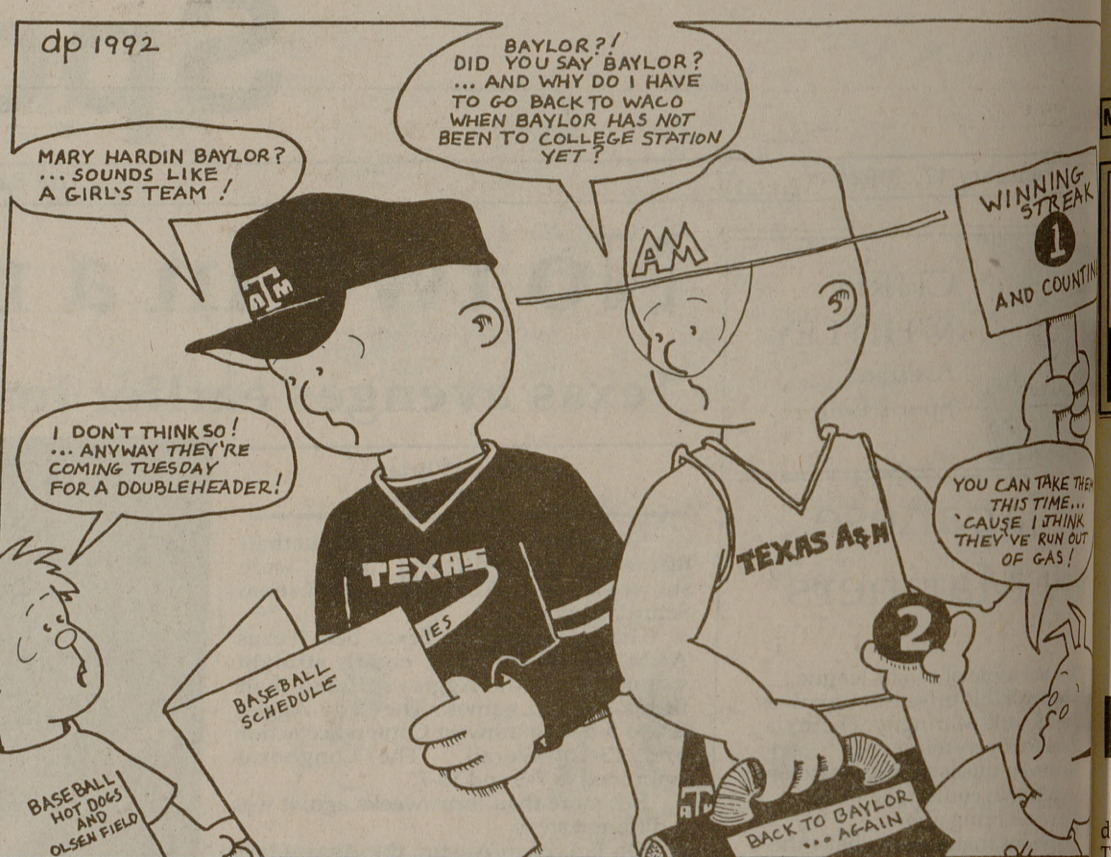

shooting night you have a tendency to panic. We were creating turnovers, but we weren't capitalizing on them.

"We needed a win tonight to get back in the conference race."

Texas coach Jody Conradt said her team has been playing with a new attitude since it lost to the Aggies in January.

"The game was turned around by defensive effort," Conradt said. "There was a point when we were everywhere."

"This is a team that's having a lot of fun right now and that's well deserved. There might be better teams in the country, but no one is having as much fun playing basketball."

Texas center Cinieta Henderson, who scored 14 points and pulled down seven rebounds, said the Longhorns have improved since they played the Aggies.

"We were ready to play tonight," Henderson said. "I think we're just that much better. We just got tired of losing. We got together as a team and started trusting each other."

A&M pulled to within six points in the second half when a Russo jumper made the score 40-46 with 14:47 to play, but Texas answered with a 17-4 run that put the game away.

A&M guard Sheri Dillard, who scored eight points, said the Aggies never gave up.

"I think we came out ready to play," Dillard said. "But Texas came out with that same type of play. Their offense was pretty much the same in the second half. They were just more intense."

The Lady Aggies play Baylor on Wednesday night in Waco. Tip-off is 5 p.m.


