with self-worth issues in addition to drugs and alcohol.  
"Students Making Awareness a Real Topic go to junior high classes speaking about self-esteem, alcoholism and the strengths to avoid alcohol in their lives," Reardon said.  
Hofmann, a coordinator for Student Athlete Development, said she gives drug and alcohol information to athletes and helps out with athlete service groups.  
One volunteer organization, Aggie Athletes Involved, helps with outreach programs at schools in the community. Student athletes in this group serve as role models for youth, educating them on drug and alcohol prevention in addition to other issues, Hofmann said.  
As another service, the center also schedules rooms on campus for Alcoholics Anonymous meetings that occur every day and for Adult Children of Alcoholics meetings once a week. The center also has information on campus organizations like Boost Alcoholism Awareness, Concerning the Health of University Students (BACCHUS), AA, Narcotics Anonymous, Cocaine Anonymous, and ACA.
