The 35 -year-old veteran took

points, seven rebounds and five assists in the quarter, then re-
urned briefly in the final period, narrowly missing his first triple-
double.
Boston broke away from a 59-
tie in the decisive third period,
utscoring the Mavericks $19-9$ to outscoring the Mavericks 19-9 to
take a a 78.68 advantage into the final quarter.
Given a standing ovation when introduced, Bird threw up a
brick on his first shot from 18 feet,
