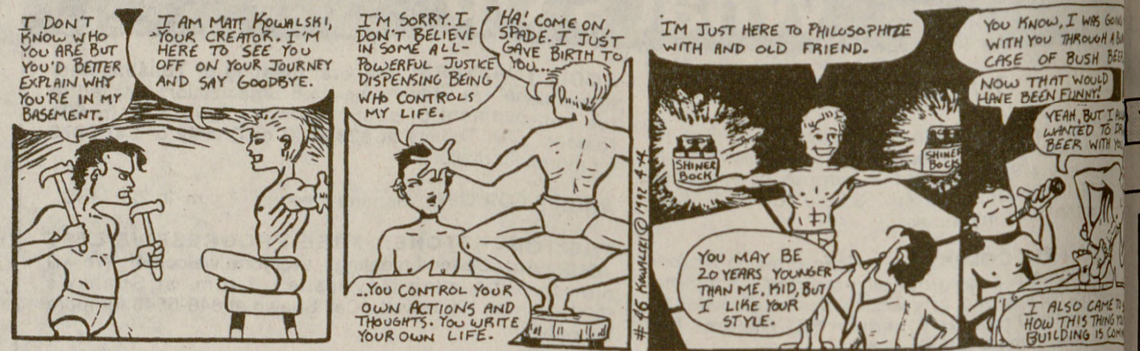
ister for more than 19 hours. Last fall the add-drop period was changed to try and improve the registration process. The add days were changed from the first five class days to the first seven, and the drop days were decreased from the first 12 class days to the first five. Sheppard said that classes that were full in past semesters had

many spaces because so many students dropped the class during the first week of class because they didn't actually need to take it. Now with the add days exceeding the drop days, some of that problem has been eliminated, she said, because students can pick up classes that have been dropped. Poenisch said that hopefully this system will enhance the registration process.

"Every summer we are sensitive to the shortage of classes for freshman students," he said. "We have been fortunate to get schedules in the past for most of the students." Poenisch said with fewer classes available the administration does the best job it can. "We have good intentions to provide as many classes as possible for all the students," he said.

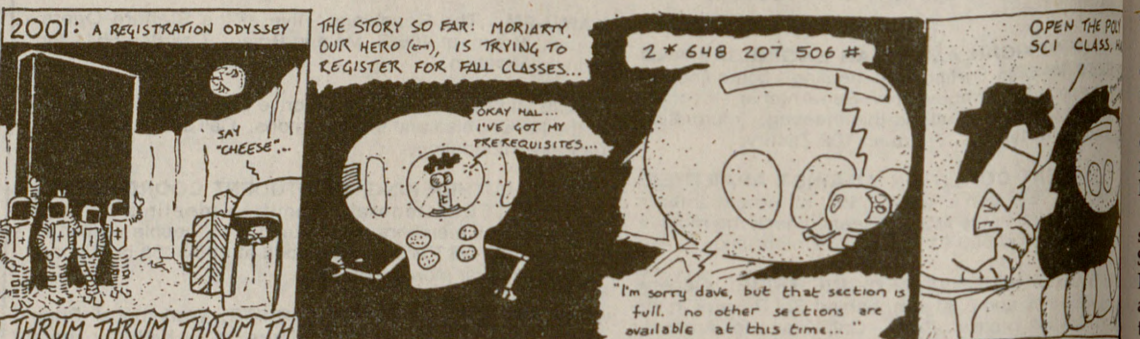

Anger at women fuels rapists

Studies show over half of sexual assault victims know their attacker

disagree with the idea of castration," she says. "It's fine and dandy, but it's not relevant to the issue at hand. The sex drive may be gone, but the anger is still there." The primary catalyst for a sexual assault is anger towards women and a rapist's need to control and humiliate, Castoria says. Sometimes rapists will target particular age groups, such as the elderly or children, she says. This typically relates back to the rapist's childhood and a specific person such as a grandmother who hurt the rapist either physically or mentally. Pedophiles, or child molesters, were probably victims of sexual abuse in their early years as well, says Castoria.

One problem with analyzing rapists is that most rapists do not exhibit certain characteristics in everyday life. "The urge is so strong that if you're in the wrong place at the wrong time, you will become his victim," Castoria says. "It's just being overwhelmed with anger at a specific time." Gary Walker, division head of the law enforcement training department at Texas A&M, agrees with Castoria in that there is no single kind of behavior that rapists exhibit. "There are all kinds of looney-tune dudes out there with no specific behavior pattern," says Walker. "They could be introverted or extroverted, acting out on a power trip or a fantasy." Walker says there are two primary types of rapists: the "motor-cycle-gang" type that one might

be naturally suspicious of, and "who-would-have-thought-type." "It's done by a wide variety of individuals and it's so hard to tell," he says. Statistics show that over half the victims know the rapist, says Walker, but the intention is not usually exhibited in a normal relationship until it's too late. "More and more rapes are occurring where they (the victims and the assailant) know each other," he says. Walker says one of the reasons more date rapes are occurring at college campuses across the nation is due to a lack of restrictions. "Most students want their campus to be restriction-free with no dorms and 24-hour visitation hours," he says. "I think we need to educate our college folks a little more."

Acquaintance rapes growing in frequency, sergeant says

situation," he said. Cahill said acquaintance rapes are becoming common and Police Chief Edgar Feldman addressed the issue in a department meeting Monday. "The chief is very concerned that he believes every woman has the right to say 'no' and it means no and stop means stop." Cahill said Feldman made known in the meeting that he would vigorously prosecute any kind of sexual assault. "We know that it (rape) has got to be horrible to live through and it is also horrible for us to vicariously living through it - we investigate," Cahill said. Cahill said he hopes the number of rapes is so much higher than last year is because more people are coming forward and actually reporting the sexual assaults. "The number of acquaintance rapes is running ahead of last year and that is very disturbing," he said. "Maybe the incidence of reports (and not the incidence of rapes) is higher. At least we hope that's what it is." Cahill said many acquaintance or date rapes involve the use of alcohol, because people sometimes let their guard down when they drink, especially around people they know. "We just want to urge women to be aware of what's going on around them," he said. "It can be thought of as a self-help measure."
