

JERUSALEM - To get to your neighborhood grocery in this 3,500-year-old city, you may have to brave the Valley of the Ghosts, cross the Bridge of ife, or pass by Gates of Justice.

Forget about Main Street. The street names here betray a fiery history of war, conquest and politics

The Way of the Prophets leads to Words of Truth. Valley of the Crucifixion Street crosses Gates of Mercy. Mule Drivers Street, named for a World War I British brigade, runs into Ghetto Fighters, which nemorializes Jews who fought the Nazis

On the biblical Hill of Evil Counsel, there is Those Who Are Hanged Street, named for pre-state Jewish underground fighters condemned by the British.

Despite its name, a popular meeting place in the old walled city is the Dung Gate, called so after a nearby dump. It's not far from the Way of Suffering, more popularly known by the Latin name Via Dolorosa, the route tradition says Jesus took to his cru-

Imagine living on Every Generation Has Its Preachers Street — origin unknown.

Moshe Piro, who has been affixing street signs here for the past 30 years, said at least 70 percent of Jerusalem's 2,000 streets have been paved and

named since Israeli independence in 1948.

Open an Israeli map of Jerusalem and show it to a Palestinian; chances are he won't recognize some of the names. Street names are contentious anywhere, but particularly in the Holy City, with its clash of religions, cultures and peoples.


