## Media overlooks important issues in campaign coverage, Ogden says

The most important issues of the presidential campaign are not talked about, State Representative Steven Ogden said at a meeting last night.

To an audience of A&M College Republicans, Ogden claimed foreign affairs and future judiciary appointments have been overlooked, and Ogden blamed the media for the oversight.

Clinton has no experience as far as foreign affairs are concerned, but he said voters don't hear anything about it in the media. He said the liberal appointments to the Supreme Court would effect the lives of every American since the liberal judges would not just interpret the laws, they would make them. But, Ogden said, the media pays no attention to this issue either.

"These issues aren't sexy enough for the media to pay attention to," Ogden said.

Besides the media, Ogden took aim at the University of Texas, the UT "alumni" and Texas Railroad Commissioner Lena Guerrero and Texas Governor Ann Richards.

He pointed at each and claimed they are responsible, in part for the "moral blindspot" in America. Ogden criticized Richards' statement that records, not personal lives, of politicians should be the factor behind their appointments.

In other business at the meeting, Young Republicans President Phil Meuret praised the Quayle rally and the efforts of the group that organized it.

"There is no other organization in the nation that could have pulled off that type of a rally in three days," he said.

"Vice President Dan Quayle had never had that type of rally for him in his career and Texas A&M gave it to him - the A&M College Republicans gave it to him."

Meuret also praised the "rally crew" for giving up the chance to meet Vice President Quayle in order to place themselves among the audience and encourage the crowd to respond to his speech.
