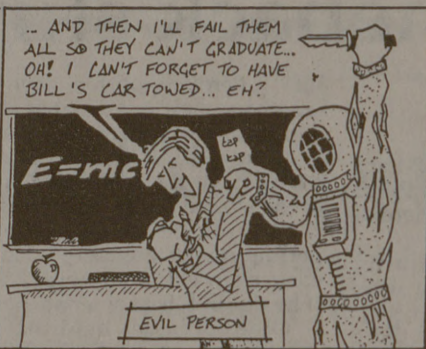
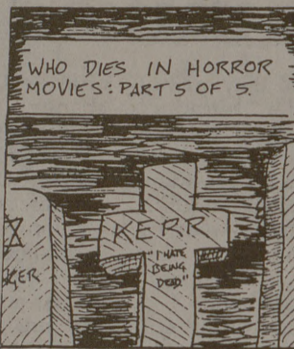

rector of Affirmative Action and Diversity at Nebraska.

Texas A&M University Police Chief Bob Wiatt said A&M has not received any phone calls from Nebraska concerning this incident.

Opal said she has offered some information regarding sensitive matters involving students.

"As an adviser, we have an obligation - I have an obligation - to do whatever I can to get (students) through any legal procedure," Opal said.

She said faculty cannot file charges for students, but they can let them know what their options are.

Dean of Faculties Dr. Bill Perry said he wasn't aware of any rule that required a faculty member to report situations of criminal wrongdoing, but did say everyone has a civic duty.

"Everybody has a duty as a cit-

izen to report anything they feel is wrong," Perry said.

"Don't do anything stupid, or anything that makes you feel uncomfortable," Opal said. "Just be smart."

Wiatt said one of the main problems is that students aren't sure what to do when put in a potentially dangerous situation.

"If you believe you have someone in your midst that is a sexual offender and poses a threat to students or faculty, you've got a responsibility to report him to the proper authorities," he said.

a deferential bow to the volunteers he said had urged him to reconsider his earlier refusal to run. However, spending reports filed with the government indicate he has spent millions since his nominal withdrawal to maintain a political infrastructure and make sure his name was placed on all 50 state ballots.

He reportedly has 20 or more commercials ready to go.

Bush declined to answer questions about Perot as he arrived at

the White House from Camp David. Clinton, campaigning in Wisconsin, said, "I'm going to run my race" regardless of Perot. "I think my fight is with George Bush."

Perot, capitalizing on widespread voter dissatisfaction, said his fight was with both parties and a political system that has allowed the economy to deteriorate. "We've got to put our people back to work," he said. To rejuvenate the economy, Perot has prepared a detailed plan to cut the deficit, including a mixture of higher taxes and spending cuts.

He added, "Our people are good; the American people are good, but their government is a

mess." He said his fight was with both parties, and the political system itself.

Perot was accompanied by his wife Margot and the man tapped to be his vice presidential running mate. Retired Adm. James Stockdale is a former Vietnam prisoner of war and a Medal of Honor winner - in Perot's words "a man of steel."

"I'm honored to accept their request" to run, he said.

Critics contend Perot is on a crusade to refurbish his tattered image, while supporters say he's being honest when he says his goal is to focus attention on deficit reduction and other economic matters.
