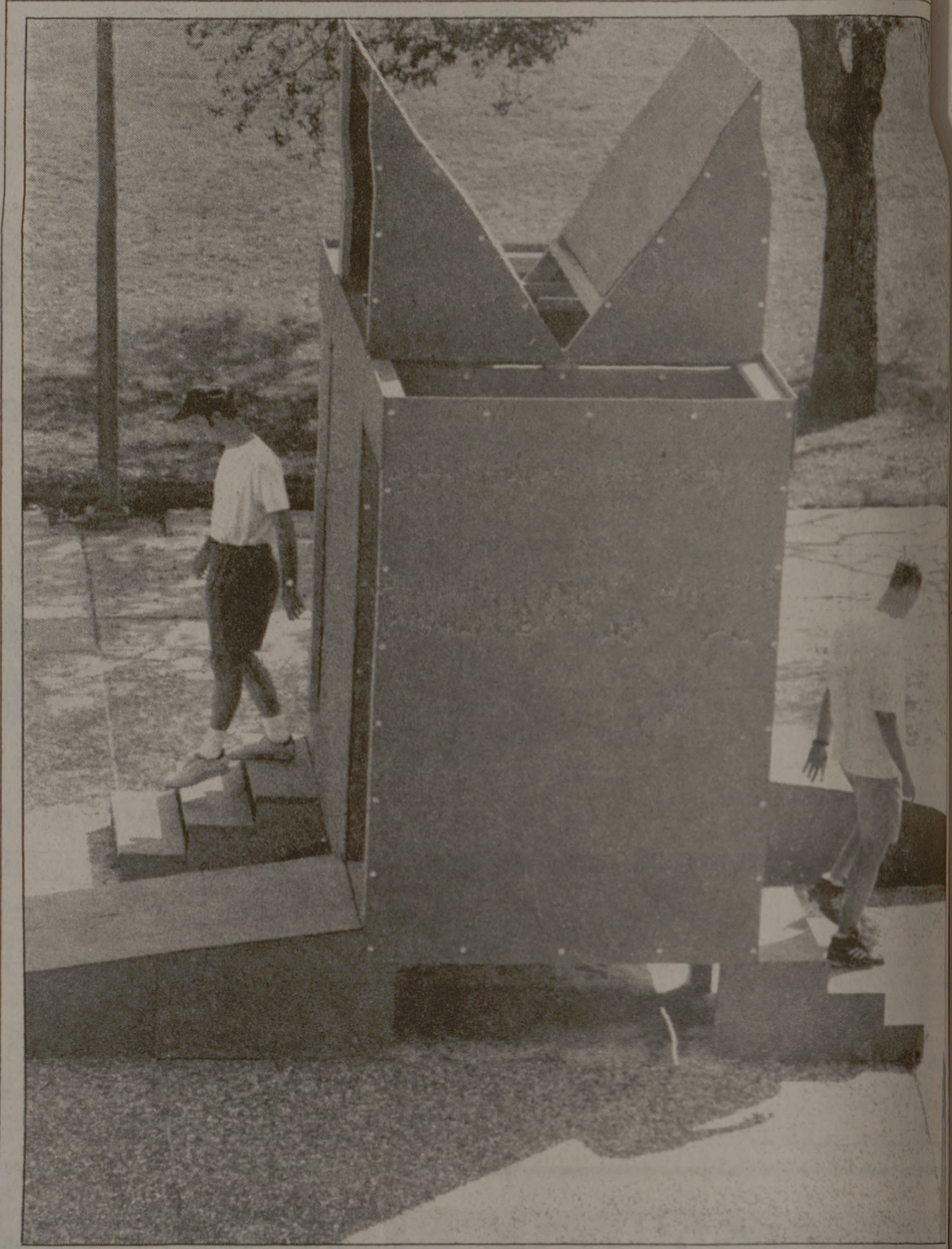

Banned Japanese wire taken from company to highway

HOUSTON — Thousands of tons of Japanese-made steel wire have been channeled from a Houston company to dozens of state highway projects, violating federal and state laws that require the use of American-made products, according to a copyright report Sunday.

Industry sources and records obtained by the Houston Chronicle indicate the Texas Department of Transportation, which builds and maintains highways and bridges, has failed to enforce the federal Buy American Act since the mid-1980s.

The infraction puts the department at risk of being fined and losing millions in federal highway dollars, the newspaper said.

Billy R. Neeley, director of materials and tests for the highway department, said the state doesn't enforce the law because it has a lack of manpower and equipment.

"We're counting on their word (that) it's domestic cable, and if they are lying they're getting away with it," Neeley said.

The manufacturer is Shinko Wire America Inc., the Houston subsidiary of Shinko Wire Co. Ltd., based in Amagasaki, Japan, near Kobe.

The Chronicle obtained inventory and production documents from Shinko with notes telling how to mix Japanese Kobe steel with American-made Bethlehem steel in making seven-wire strand, used primarily in concrete beams for highways.

Dave Geiger, chief of the contract branch for the Federal Highway Administration in Washington, D.C., said steel rod imported from foreign sources does not comply with the Buy American Act requiring use of domestic products in federally funded highway projects.

Shinko Wire America said in a statement issued Friday, "In agreement with the aid of its parent company, is investigating the matter. At the present, the portion imported rod is very small."

The statement, issued by the company's attorney, Andy S. Wood, also said that "present management was not a part of the company" during the mid-1980s to 1990, the period that documents indicated that Japanese-made steel was used.

Judge seals assault case settlement

SAN ANTONIO — An acting judge has sealed settlements in two personal injury lawsuits, both of which involve complaints of alleged sexual assaults against children, the San Antonio Express-News reported Sunday.

The order from Judge Martha Tanner hides the identity not only of the victims and their parents, but of the defendants as well.

However, the defendants, who agreed to undisclosed insurance settlements, include a private psychiatric hospital and a retail business establishment, the newspaper reported. The names appeared in public records of the criminal cases.

Tanner set a hearing for 8:30 a.m. Wednesday to rule on whether the records will be sealed permanently.

In an interview last week, the judge said she is unsure how she will rule.

"I have a bad problem with it (the sealing request)," the judge said.

"I will have to weigh that against the rights of an innocent child. I didn't seal the records for one minute to protect the hospital. If there is no objection, I will probably seal it."

The personal injury lawsuits allege sexual assaults on a 15-year-old boy and on a 10-year-old boy by a 27-year-old social worker, the newspaper said. The social worker has been indicted on two charges of aggravated sexual assault.

The man's court-appointed attorney said his client is terminally ill with AIDS.
