## No revenge for Lady Aggies

 Texas disposes of A\&M in three games in front of record crowd> By J. DOUGLAS FOSTER AUSTIN - When the Texas A\&M Lady Aggies hosted the University of Texas on Oct. 7 , Texas swept through G. Rollie finishing A\&M off in a match that lasted less than an hour. Wednesday night in Austin, the Lady three weeks ago, taking the Lady Aggie down in three games by scores of $15-10$
dow 5-3 and 15-11. Texas, now 18-3, 7-1 in Southwest
Conference play, disposed of A\&M in
front of a Recreational Sports Center front of a Recreational Sports Center record crowd of 2127 despite playing ithout starters Angie Breitenfield and with an injury. The Lady Aggies fall to 12-9, 3-5 in conference play. The Lady Aggies finished the match
with a minus .009 hitting percentage, and the Lady Longhorns hit .236 . In the first game, neither team was Texas' 132 hitting percentage outdid A\&M's .063. The Lady Aggies had only 10 kills on 32 attempts compared to the Lady Longhorns' 14 kills on 38 attempts. In game two, Texas looked as if they cruising past $\mathrm{A} \& \mathrm{M}$ by a score of $15-3$. Af ter opening the match with a 6-0 run, the
Lady Longhorns saw the Lady Aggies ady Longhorns saw the Lady Aggie $9-0$ run to seal the win and put A\&M down two games to none.
The Lady Aggies finished game tw The Lady Aggies finished game
with a minus 158 hitting percentage Junior Katy Jameyson and sophomor amy Duarte led the Lady Longhorns hrough game two, combining for 11 kills

Jameyson, who finished the match
with a 400 hitting percentage thanks to 10 kills on 20 attempts and only two errors, said the Lady. Aggies played her
squad a tougher match this time, but that her team played well enough offensively to pull out the win.
