

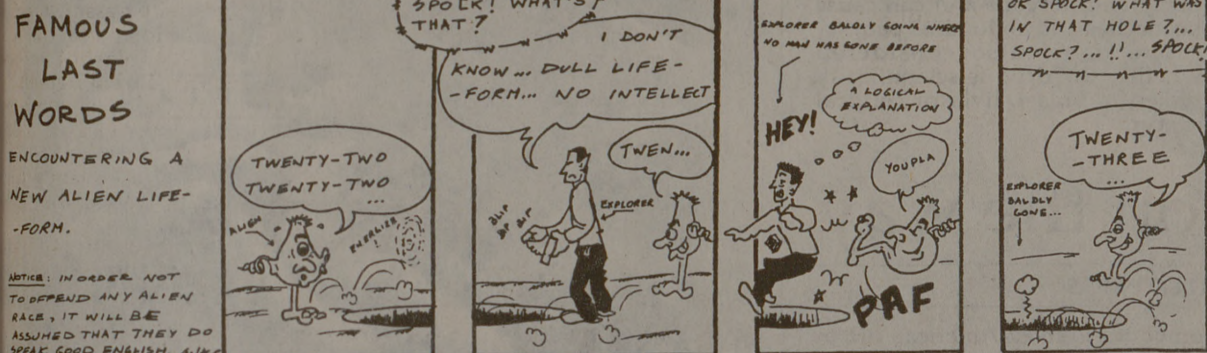

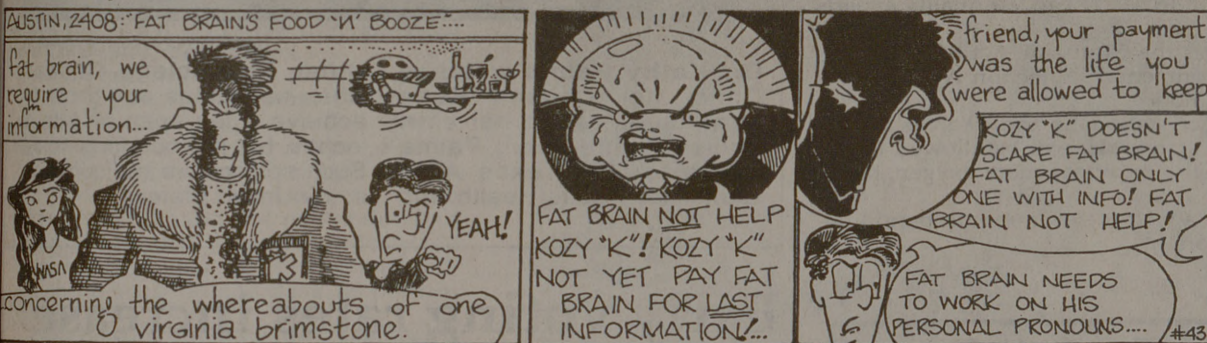

**Crime Stoppers**

**Gunman sought by Bryan police**

It was 11:48 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 18 when a black male wearing a long, dark coat entered the Easy Shop convenience store on the corner of LaBrisa Drive and FM 2818 in Bryan. As the male approached the counter, he pulled a rifle from under his coat, threatened the clerk with the gun, and then demanded she open the cash register and hand over her purse. The suspect bolted from the store and was last seen running west on LaBrisa Drive.

Witnesses described the suspect as a black male, approximately 40 years old, 5 feet 5 inches tall, thin build, with a moustache and goatee. Bryan police detectives report the suspect has been involved in three convenience store robberies in the last two weeks.

This week the Bryan Police Department and Crime Stoppers need your help to identify the person responsible for these robberies. If you have information that could be helpful, call Crime Stoppers at 775-TIPS. When you call, Crime Stoppers will assign you a special coded number that will protect your identity.

If your call leads to an arrest and grand jury indictment, Crime Stoppers will pay you up to \$1,000 in cash. Crime Stoppers also pays cash for information on any felony crime or the location of any wanted fugitive.
