## Ship collides with Greenpeace boat tracking freighter carrying plutonium

PARIS — A Japanese escort ship collided Sunday with a Greenpeace boat tracking a freighter laden with highly toxic plutonium, the Greenpeace crew said. Japan is shipping the plutonium home to fire up a new generation of nuclear fast-breeder reactors. Greenpeace opposes the shipment and is tracking it, saying the plutonium poses huge dangers ranging from a spill to an attack by terrorists seeking nuclear bomb-making material.

The freighter Akatsuki Maru, carrying 1.7 tons of plutonium, slipped out of the French port of Cherbourg late Saturday after a day of violent clashes between security forces and environmentalists.

The vessel's route on its two-month voyage to Yokohama is secret. But Greenpeace said the freighter and its armed escort, a Japanese warship, were sailing southwest in the Atlantic and could reach Portugal's Azores Islands by Wednesday.

The sideswipe collision in the English Channel damaged the helicopter landing decks of the warship Shikishima and the Greenpeace boat Solo, the group said. There were no reported injuries.

A speck of plutonium inhaled can kill a human. It is also the key ingredient in nuclear weapons. Though France insists the shipment is not weapons quality, Greenpeace says it could be used to make 120 crude bombs.
