**Volleyball advance**

The Texas A&M Lady Aggie volleyball team will be trying to get back on the winning track Saturday when they take on the University of Texas-San Antonio Lady Roadrunners at the Convocation Center on the UTSA campus.

A&M, coming off a four game match loss to the Baylor Lady Bears at the final home game of the season on Wednesday night, will be looking to pick up their second victory in the last six matches, and will also be attempting to regroup before the SWC Championships which will be held in Austin Nov. 20-22.

UTSA (18-13) is hitting for a .235 average with 14.03 kills, 12.07 assists and 17.61 digs.

The Lady Aggies will be playing their third match they have

ever played against the San Antonio school, winning both previous tilts, including a three game sweep last season, 15-6, 15-2, 15-8.

Lady Aggie head coach Givens characterized the match as one of the most important his team has had to face all season.

"I think from the standpoint of confidence and trying to gain some momentum, this is a very important match," Givens said.

Junior outside attacker Art Kislung agreed that the match will be instrumental to the success of A&M's post season hopes.

"It is very important for the team that we need to get ready for post season play, and we have got to pull together after this (Baylor) loss," Kislung said.

Givens added that he expects a tough match from the Lady Roadrunners this weekend.

"They're going to compete hard, so we're really going to have to get after it," Givens said.

final. A tape of the match confirms that Bowe did not quit, but the referee acted too hastily.

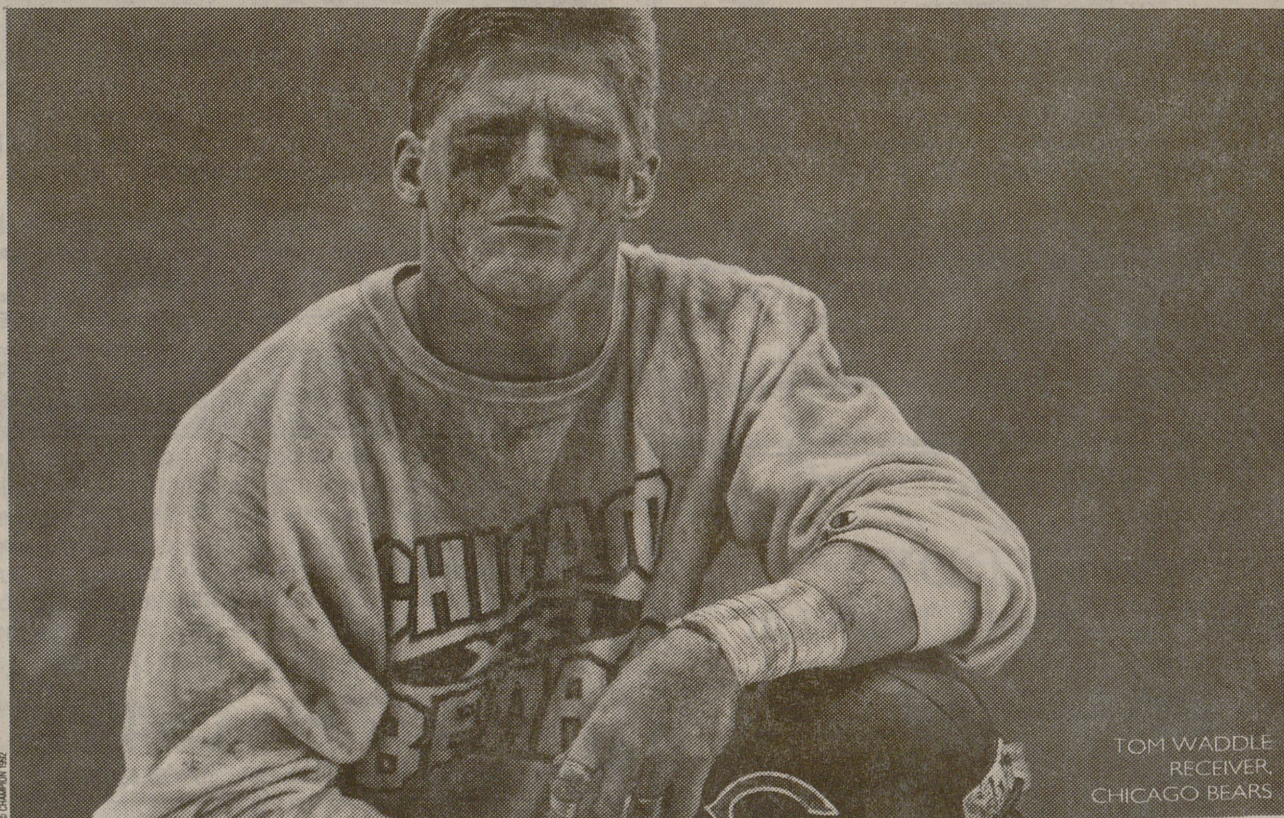
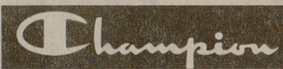

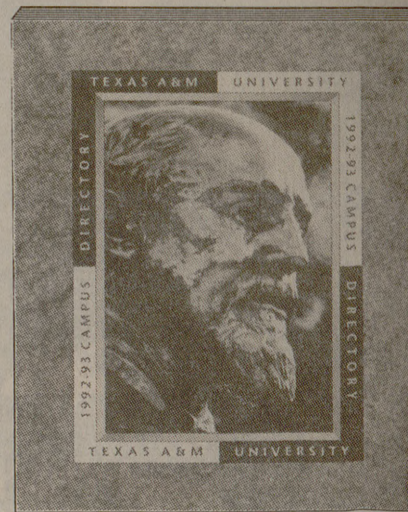
