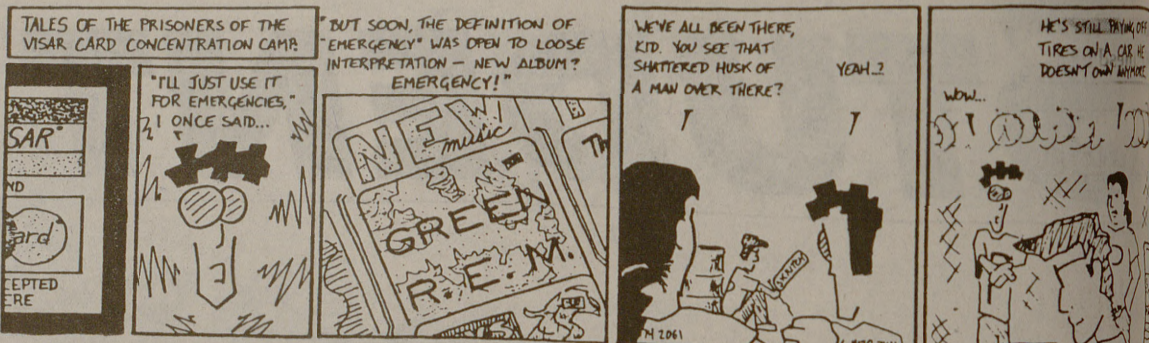

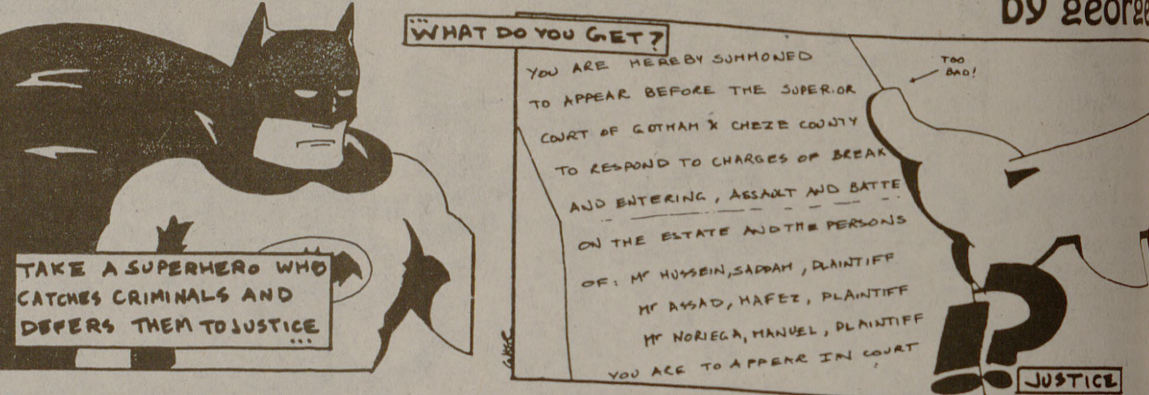

Shrimpers face federal laws

Government expands regulations protecting sea turtles

WASHINGTON — Shrimpers in the Gulf of Mexico and the southeastern Atlantic Ocean now face expanded federal regulations designed to protect sea turtles and minimize their chances of drowning in shrimpers' nets.

The National Marine Fisheries Service on Tuesday implemented expanded guidelines governing the use of turtle excluder devices on shrimping vessels — equipment that has been hotly contested by shrimpers.

The devices, known as TEDs, are escape hatches to keep air-breathing turtles from drowning in trawler nets, which can be dragged for hours at a time.

Environmentalists and conservation groups pushed use of the TEDs, citing the presence of five threatened and endangered turtle species in southern U.S. waters, including the endangered Kemp's ridley.

The National Academy of Sciences estimates that prior to partial implementation of TEDs regulations in 1989, up to 55,000 sea turtles died each year in American shrimp nets.

The full effect of the changes won't be felt until the end of 1994. But as of Tuesday, all shrimp trawlers over 25 feet operating in offshore waters were re-

Previously, shrimpers had to have a TED in their nets from March 1 through Nov. 30 in the Gulf, and May 1 through Aug. 31 in the Atlantic.

William W. Fox Jr., assistant administrator of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, which NMFS is a part.

The Texas Shrimp Association, which contends the TEDs cost shrimpers part of their catch, disagrees.

"In a year like this year in Texas, where shrimp production is very low, it may make or break a lot of shrimpers," said Jim Sagnes, legislative director for the group.

"No one can argue that TEDs don't cause a loss of catch," he said. "National Marine and Fisheries Service figures say it's less than 5 percent. We say it's over 20 percent. Whatever percent, it's a loss of product."

Shrimping is a \$600 million industry in Texas, and Sagnes said the catch this year could be half of what was projected.
