

Branch breaks assist record despite ailing shoulder

In a sport where the focus is almost always on the player that scores the most points, Texas

A&M freshman point guard Lisa Branch seems to be enjoying herself by giving instead of receiving.

Saturday's 79-74 win over Texas Christian turned out to be a showcase for Branch's ability to spark the A&M offense with her Southwest Conference record 19 assists, a total that broke the previous record of 18, which was set in 1983 by Baylor's Darlene Primeaux and tied in 1988 by Arkansas's Donna Wilson.

Her assist total does not tell the whole story about Branch's playmaking ability, however. Against TCU, all but two players finished the game without scoring a point. Four of those Lady Aggies scored in double figures, with Branch scoring 12 herself.

"She's a great player," A&M's h Burket said. "She creates a Beth Burket said. lot of our shots."


