

**Crime Stoppers**

**Crooks steal \$50,000 of equipment**

Some time during the week-end of February 20 thieves visited the Prater Equipment Company on the northwest corner of Highway 21 west and FM 2818 in Bryan.

Evidence indicates the thieves cut the padlock off of a building used to store lawn equipment, then entered the building where they examined the lawn equipment and selectively stole eight new pieces of equipment.

The owner estimates that the value of the loss exceeds \$50,000. The stolen equipment was described as:

1 - John Deere lawn and garden tractor, green with a 48-inch mower deck, MOD/GT262.

1 - John Deere lawn tractor, green with a 38-inch mower deck, MOD/LX172.

1 - John Deere riding lawn mower, green, MOD/SRX75.

1 - John Deere walk behind commercial 12 1/2 horsepower lawn mower with a 38-inch mower deck, MOD/455.

1 - John Deere lawn and garden tractor, green with a 60-inch mower deck, MOD/455.

1 - Woods walk behind commercial lawn mower, orange, MOD/5140.

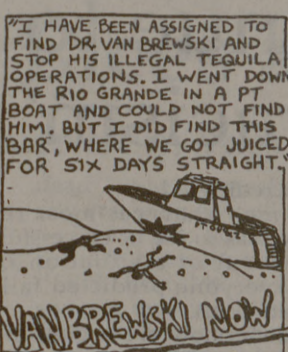
1 - Bearcat, three horsepower chipper and shredder, dark orange.
