He disagreed with burdening later generations with nuclear waste, especially when society could easily eliminate the energy source using new, innovative sources.

Hydropower shows promise as a new energy source, but problems exist because flooding often results from the damming of waterways,

he said.

"There has to be a better way," he said. "We have to find it or create it."

To create new power sources, people must apply creativity to currently existing technologies, he said. If individuals are willing to make the commitment, solar panels may provide the energy source of the future, he said.

Childs said if public figures were to show support for solar power, the public would soon follow in their support.

"Did you know that Jimmy Carter put solar

panels on the White House and Ronald Reagan took them down," he said. "If President Clinton was to put the panels back on, that would be a great symbolic gesture."

He said it will take broad action from the government, corporations and other public interest groups to make any drastic change in the way the country uses energy. But people can make a difference on a local level, he said.

"It is literally as simple as turning off the light switch when you leave the room," he said.

Maco Stewart referred to U.S. interim Sen. Bob Krueger, U.S. Reps. Joe Barton and Jack Fields, and Texas Treasurer Kay Bailey Hutchison as the "PAC-Man team."

Clymer Wright said since Krueger, Barton, Fields and Hutchison promised to fight for spending hundreds of billions of dollars for the superconducting super collider, they will have to vote for "pork" projects for other Senators.

Barton, Fields and Hutchison spoke at the meeting, but Krueger

cancelled, saying he had to stay in Washington, D.C. to cast votes on President Clinton's economic plan.

The May 1 election is for the seat left vacant by Lloyd Bentsen, who became treasury secretary.

In other campaign developments:

— Krueger said Hutchison "shows a reckless disregard for the truth" in her statement that she was the only elected official to fight a state income tax.

Mrs. Hutchison, the state's treasurer, makes the claim in a television commercial.

Krueger, a Democrat, said, "It is hard to find an elected official in Texas — Democrat or Republican — who supported an income tax."

Mass grave found at Iraqi Army HQ

NEW YORK — A secret mass grave containing hundreds of bodies was found last week on the site of a former Iraqi army headquarters in Irbil in northern Iraq, two humanitarian organizations reported Monday.

Local Kurds looking for scrap among ruins of a military complex found the grave, the first found in an area not under Iraqi control, according to Middle East Watch, a division of Human Rights Watch, and Physicians for Human Rights.

The groups said the find underscored the importance of human rights researchers having access to all Iraq.

A memorandum signed by Iraq and the United Nations, allowing such exploration by non-governmental organizations, expires this Wednesday and may well not be renewed by Iraq, they noted.

Andrew Whitley, executive director of Middle East Watch, told The Associated Press that the area formerly was headquarters of the Iraq 5th Army Corps in what now is the "no fly zone" of northern Iraq, home of most of Iraqi Kurds.


