 expenditures, could disqualify any cadet who has won a position if their total expenses exceed the spending limits set by election regulations. The cadets appealed the ruling.

Taylor, who was listed on the memorandum and therefore fined, said the penalty, if enforced, should not push his campaign expenditures over regulation levels.

"I'm not really worried about fines throwing me over budget," he said. "It's not a concern right now."

Throughout the campaign, Walker has emphasized making student government more accountable to students and create programs to bolster acceptance of multiculturalism.

Since three Texas A&M System schools were given the A&M name last month, Walker has said he will oppose any action that would allow students from other system schools to order an Aggie ring.

Taylor has said multiculturalism is the most important issue facing the student body. During his campaign, he has called for student government to assume a leadership role to increase sensitivity and awareness of other cultures on campus.

Both candidates said they will continue to promote their platforms until the election.

"I have high hopes about the runoff," Walker said. "We're taking it one step at a time. We have accomplished one goal, and now we have one more to go."

Taylor said he has one objective to pursue.

"My job is to look at getting elected," he said.
