Romania files lawsuit for paintings Tubularman

NEW YORK - Once upon a time in Romania, Communists forced the king into exile. But as he left, he stripped his castle of art treasures and spirited them abroad.

Romania charges in a \$500 mil-lion lawsuit that the 40 paintings by El Greco, Rembrandt, Titian, Breughel, Caravaggio, Van Dyck and others belong to the country.

Michael, 72, contends that the paintings are his because the 1889 will of his grandfather King Carol I bequeathed the art to the Romanian Crown, and he is still the legal king despite being forced to abdicate on Dec. 30, 1947.


The current Romanian government, which overthrew the Com-munists in 1989, filed the lawsuit in state court in May. It was filed here because two of the paintings may have been sold at a New York art gallery.

Attorney Pamfil Riposanu, who filed the lawsuit, said King Carol's will does not permit any member of the royal family to take the paintings out of the coun-

try. The paintings "absolutely" belong to the Romanian people, he said

In court papers filed on behalf of Michael, who lives in Versoix, Switzerland, attorney Daniel Kornstein asked for dismissal of the lawsuit.




