Joey Buttafuoco confesses to sex with Amy Fisher

MINEOLA, N.Y. — After 11/2 years of denials, Joey Buttafuoco finally admitted it Tuesday: He slept with Amy Fisher.

He admitted it happened at a motel. He admitted knowing she was just 16 years old. And he admitted it all in court, where he pleaded guilty to third-degree rape and set himself up for a six-month jail term.

"On July 2, 1991, I had sexual relations with Amy Fisher at the Freeport Motel," Buttafuoco declared in a clear voice before a packed courtroom, acknowledging the affair for the first time. He appeared without his wife, Mary Jo.

Buttafuoco's plea was one of the final frames of the saga that began May 19, 1992, when Fisher shot Mary Jo Buttafuoco in the head to clear the way for her affair with Joey. Fisher is serving five-to-15 years for the shooting.

Buttafuoco, who will be sentenced Nov. 15, had nothing to say after the 20-minute hearing before Nassau County Court Judge Jack Mackston.

Under a plea bargain, Buttafuoco's sentence will be no more than six months in jail, five years' probation and a \$5,000 fine.

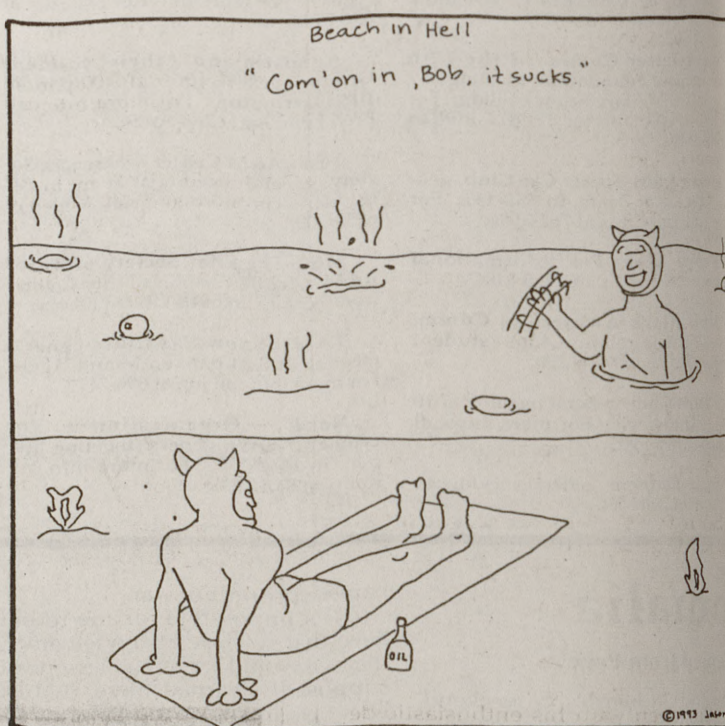
If he gets the maximum, Buttafuoco could be released after four months.

The plea to the most serious count of a 19-count indictment resolves the whole case.

Fisher's lawyer, Philip Catapano, said of the plea that "at least the world will know Amy Fisher was not lying."

Fisher charged they had an affair that including trysts in four motels, Buttafuoco's auto body shop on New York's Long Island and aboard his boat, "Double Trouble." Fisher, now 19, was only 16 when the affair began, which is below the legal age of consent in New York state.

thought most of the hatred came from competition, primarily over women.

Although many of the participants disagreed on the cause of the problem, most agreed that the problem needs to be resolved.

Jimmy Statathos, vice president of the Inter-Fraternity Council said blacks need to break down the barriers of hatred over important issues and band together to fight racism.

"If you're worried about battles between athletes and Greeks, you won't have energy to fight important battles of life," he said.

Trent Walters, defensive back coach for the A&M football team, said the tension between Greeks

and athletes is not special to A&M. It was prominent on the previous campuses he has worked on.

"It's sad that blacks on a predominantly white campus can't get along," he said. "We should be fighting racism instead of each other."

Butler said one of the main causes of tension comes from visiting fraternities and sororities trying to continue a rivalry at A&M that is present on their campus.

"We have to tell we don't hate the Alphas and we don't hate the Deltas on this campus," he said.

This would alleviate the tension and help us to get along better, he said.

Tanya Williams, a senior journalism major and member of the Black Awareness Committee as well as a sorority, said another possible solution to the problem of tension is individuality.
